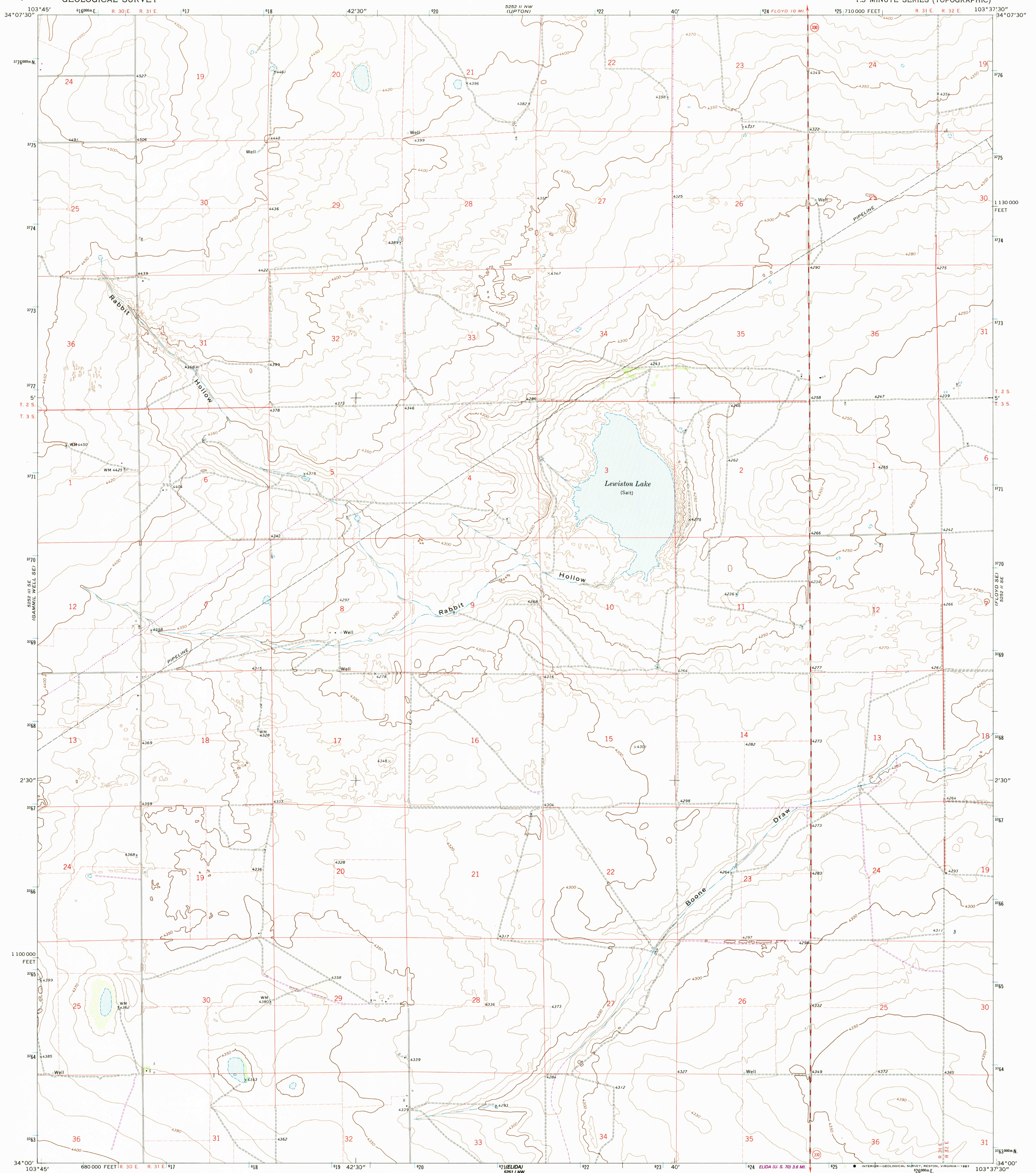

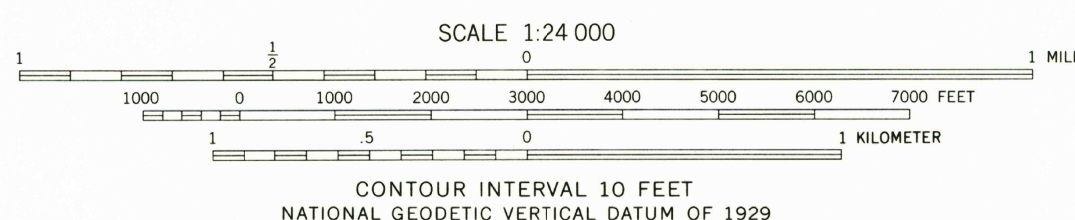
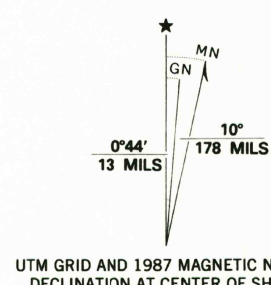
Projection and 10,000-foot grid ticks: New Mexico coordinate
