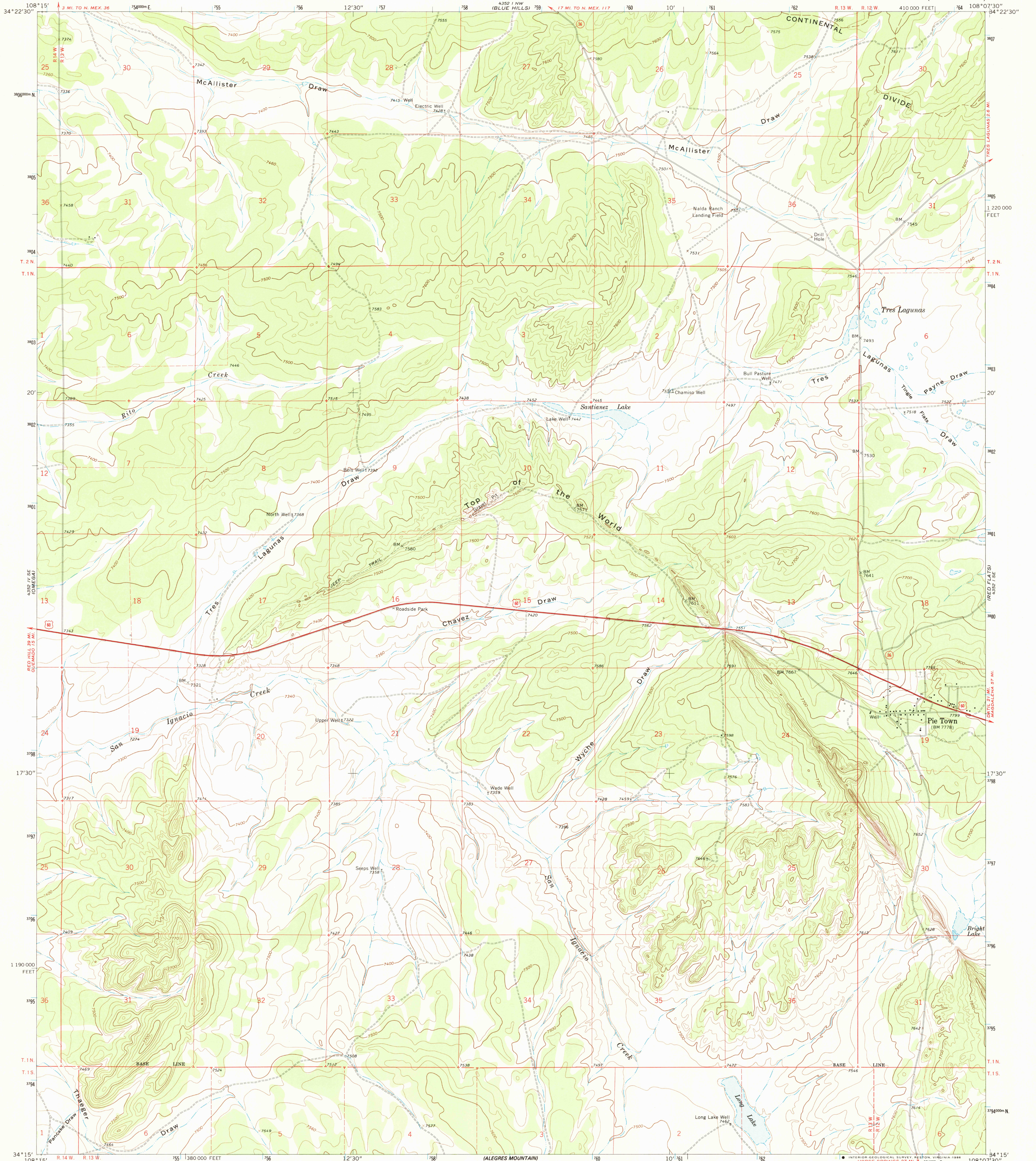

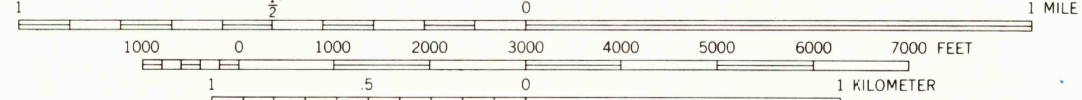
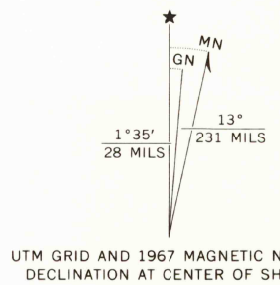
Polyconic projection. 1927 North American Datum

1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 12, shown in blue

Fine red dashed lines indicate selected fence lines

To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 2 meters south and 56 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks

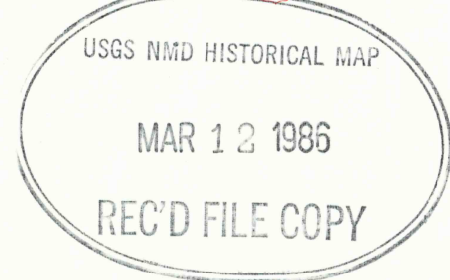
