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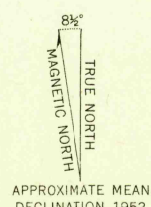

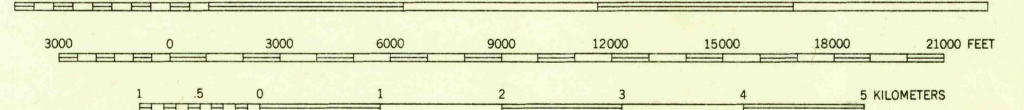

Contours in strip mine areas compiled from 1951 photography

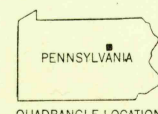
