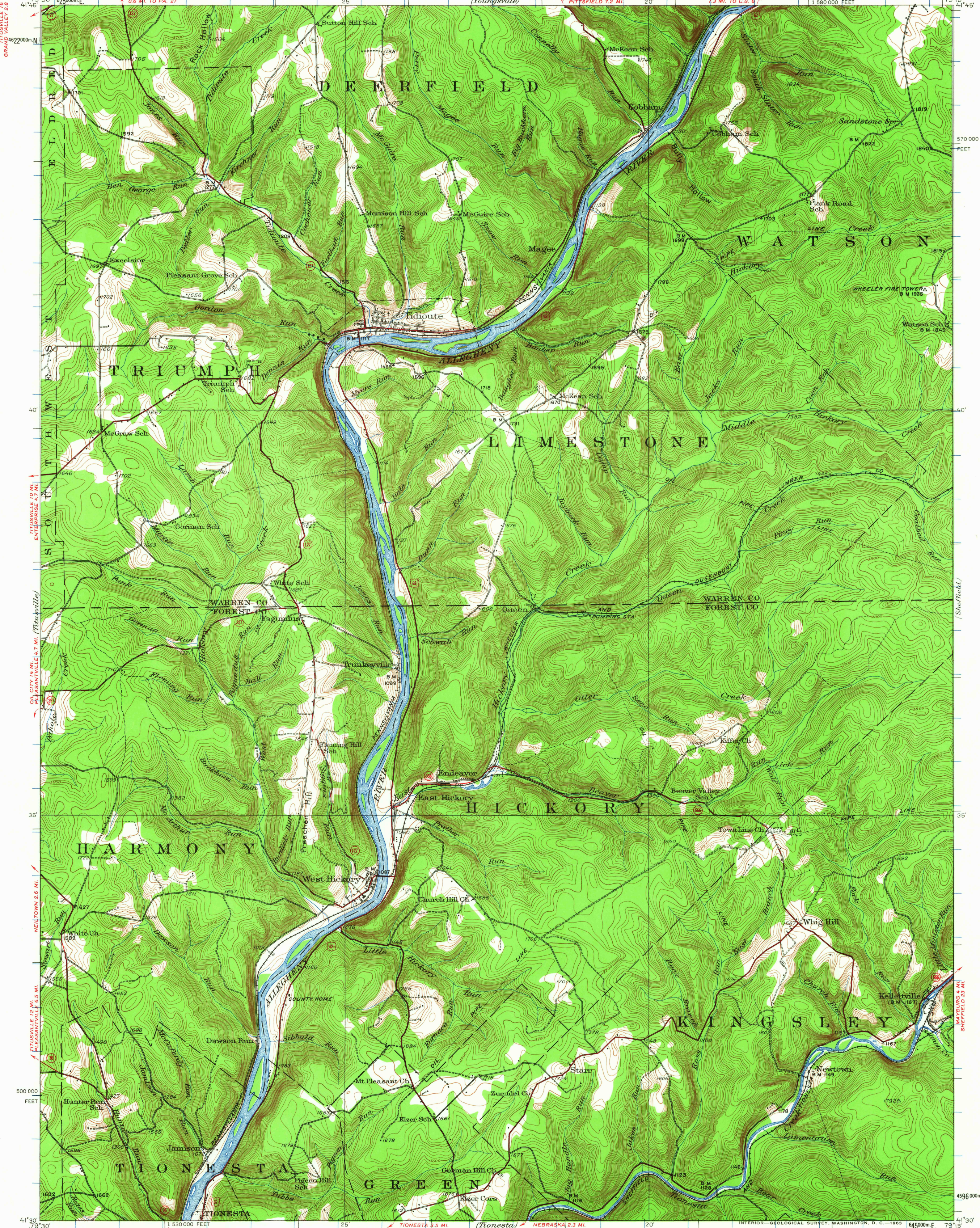

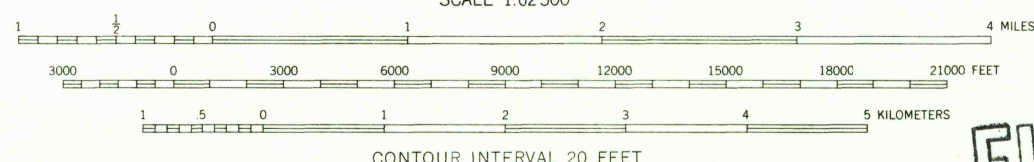
PENNSYLVANIA
