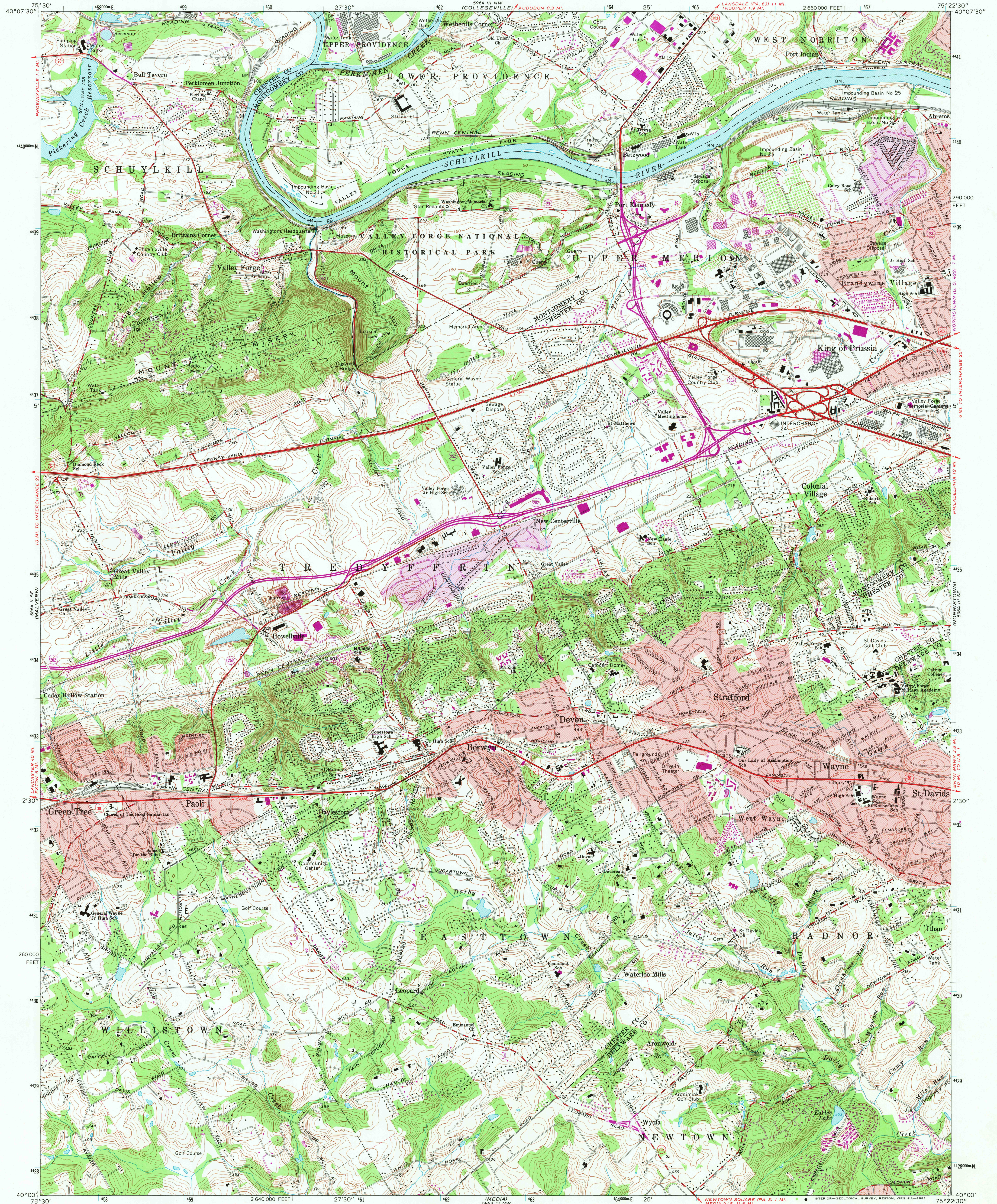

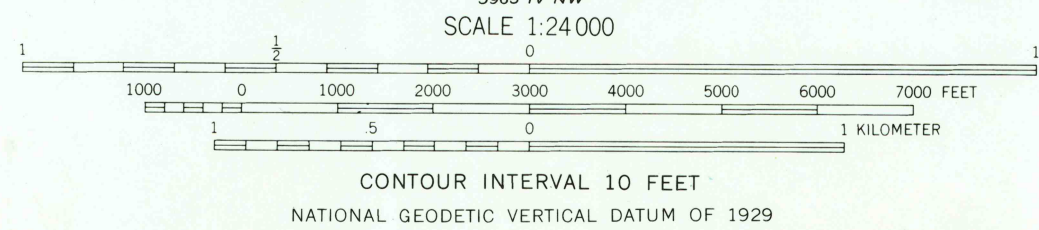
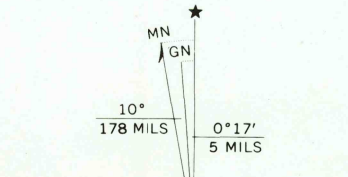

Topography by photogrammetric methods from aerial photographs taken 1950. Field checked 1952. Revised from aerial photographs taken 1965. Field checked 1966

Polyconic projection. 10,000-foot grid ticks based on Pennsylvania coordinate system, south zone. 1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 18 shown in blue. 1927 North American Datum. To place on predicted North American Datum 1983, move projection lines 6 meters south and 31 meters west as shown by dashed corner ticks

Fine red dashed lines indicate selected fence and field lines where generally visible on aerial photographs. This information is unchecked

Red tint indicates areas in which only landmark buildings are shown
