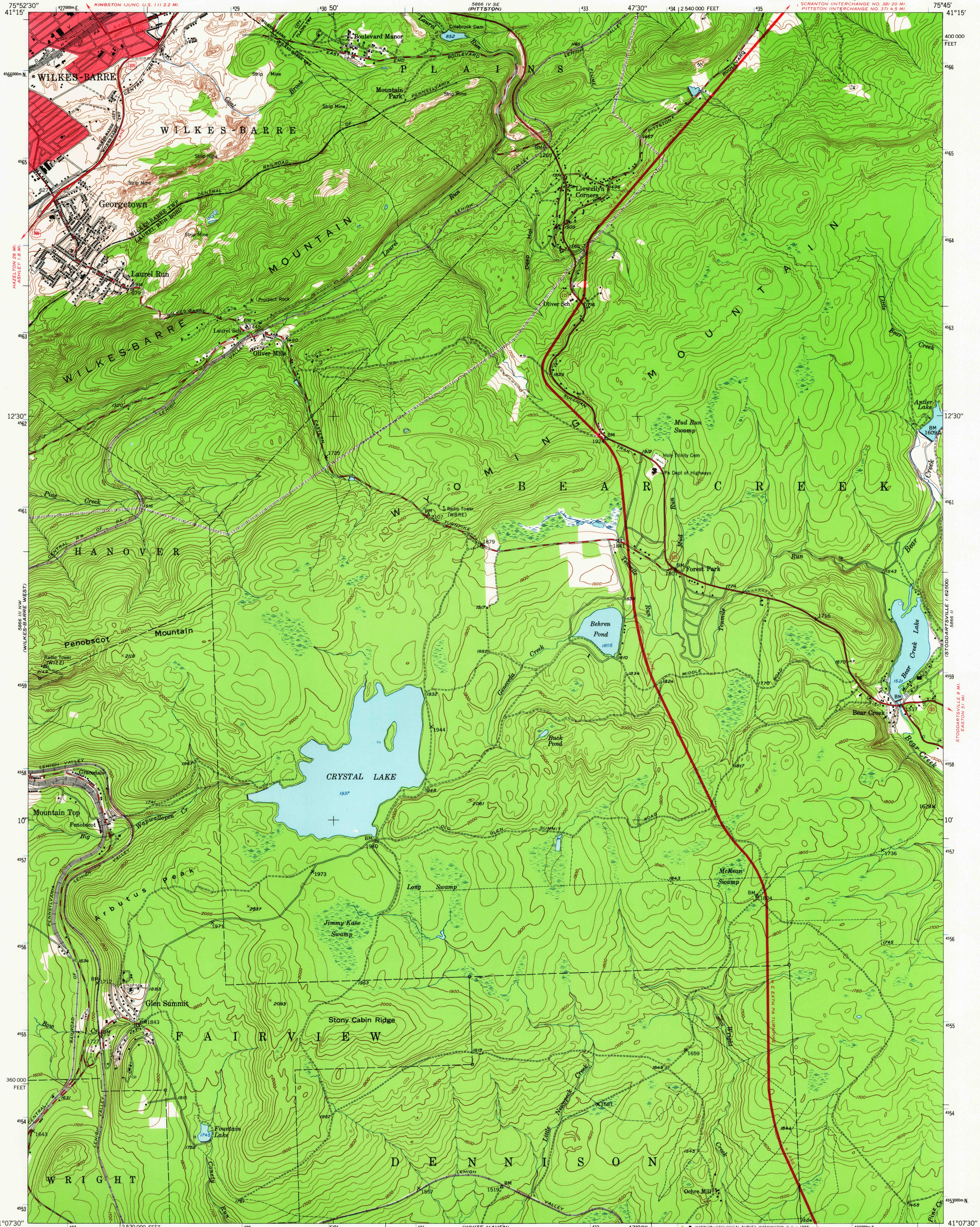

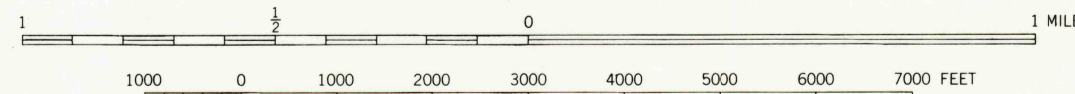
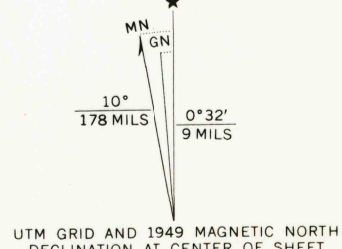

compiled from 1942 photography

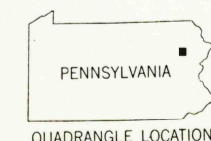
1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks,
