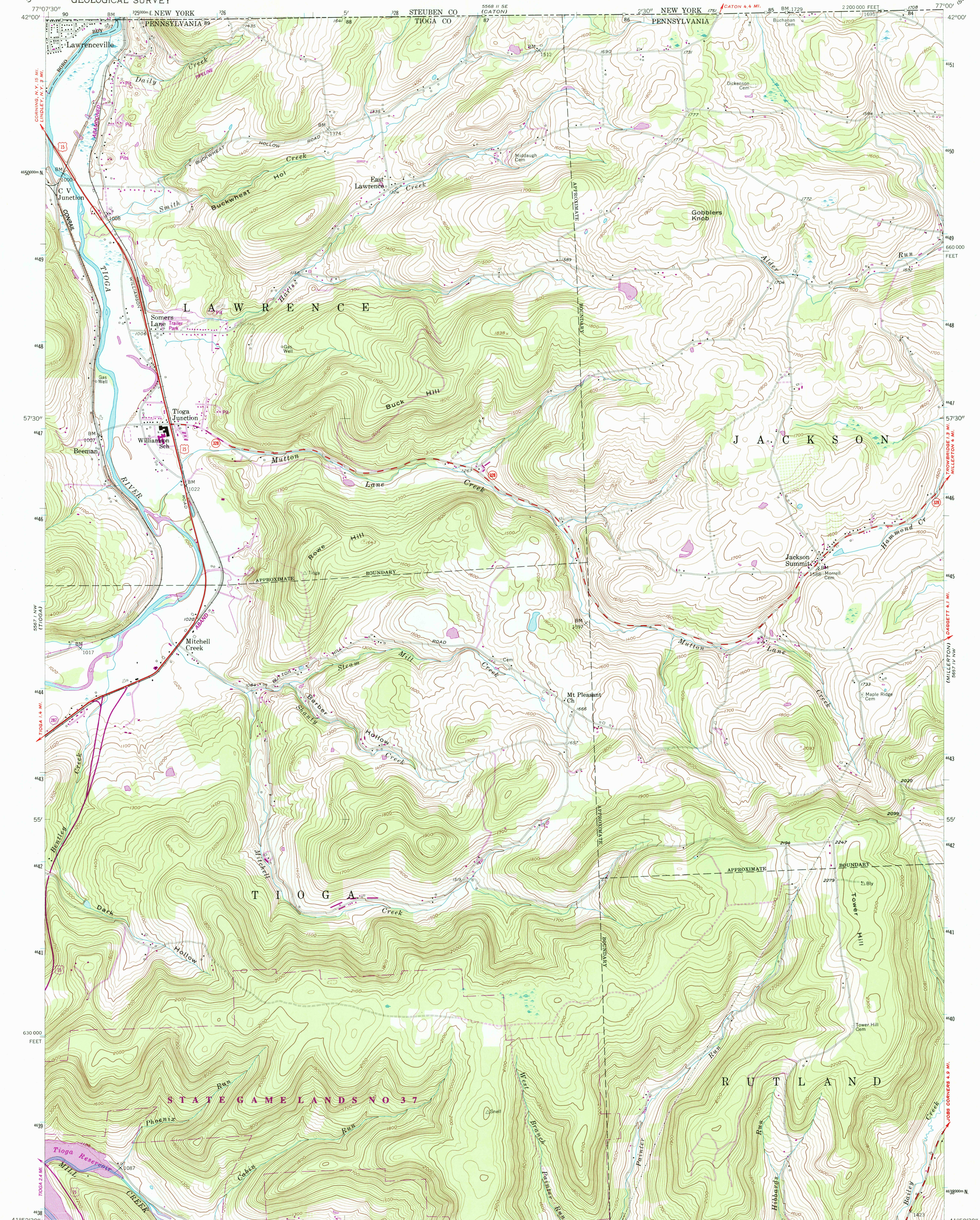

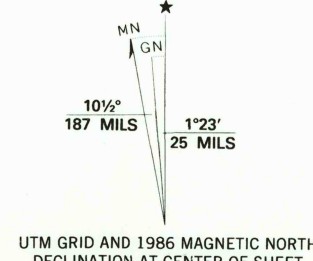

Polyconic projection. 1927 North American datum. 10,000-foot grid based on Pennsylvania coordinate system, north zone

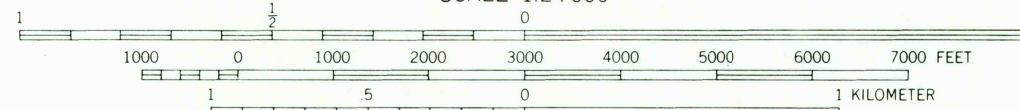
1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 18, shown in blue

To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983, move the projection lines 4 meters south and 26 meters west as shown by dashed corner ticks

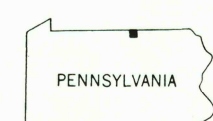
