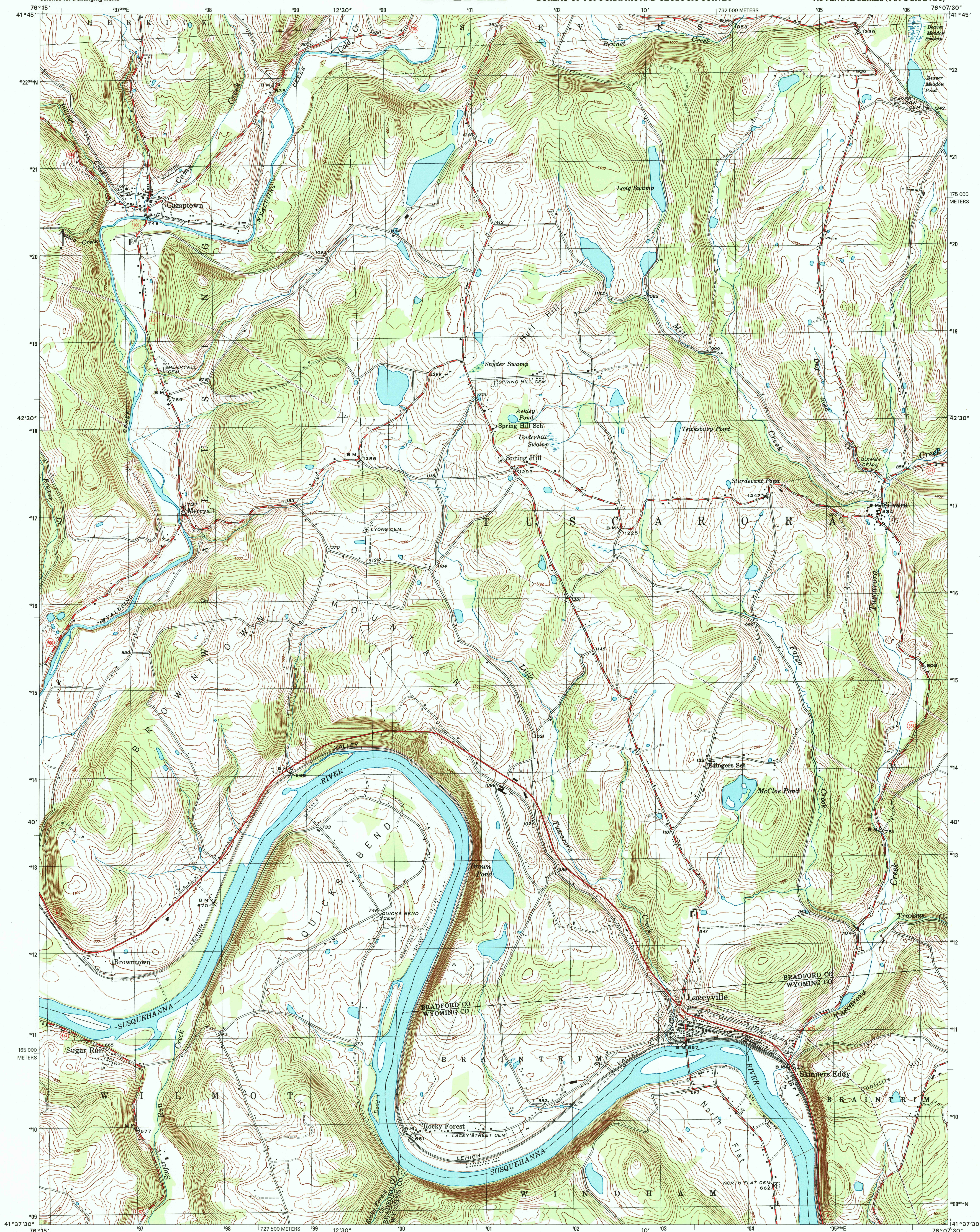

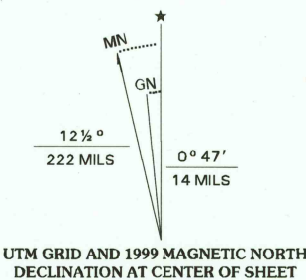

(north zone)

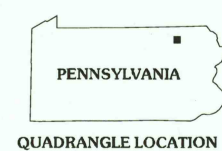
North American Datum of 1927 (NAD 27) is shown by dashed
