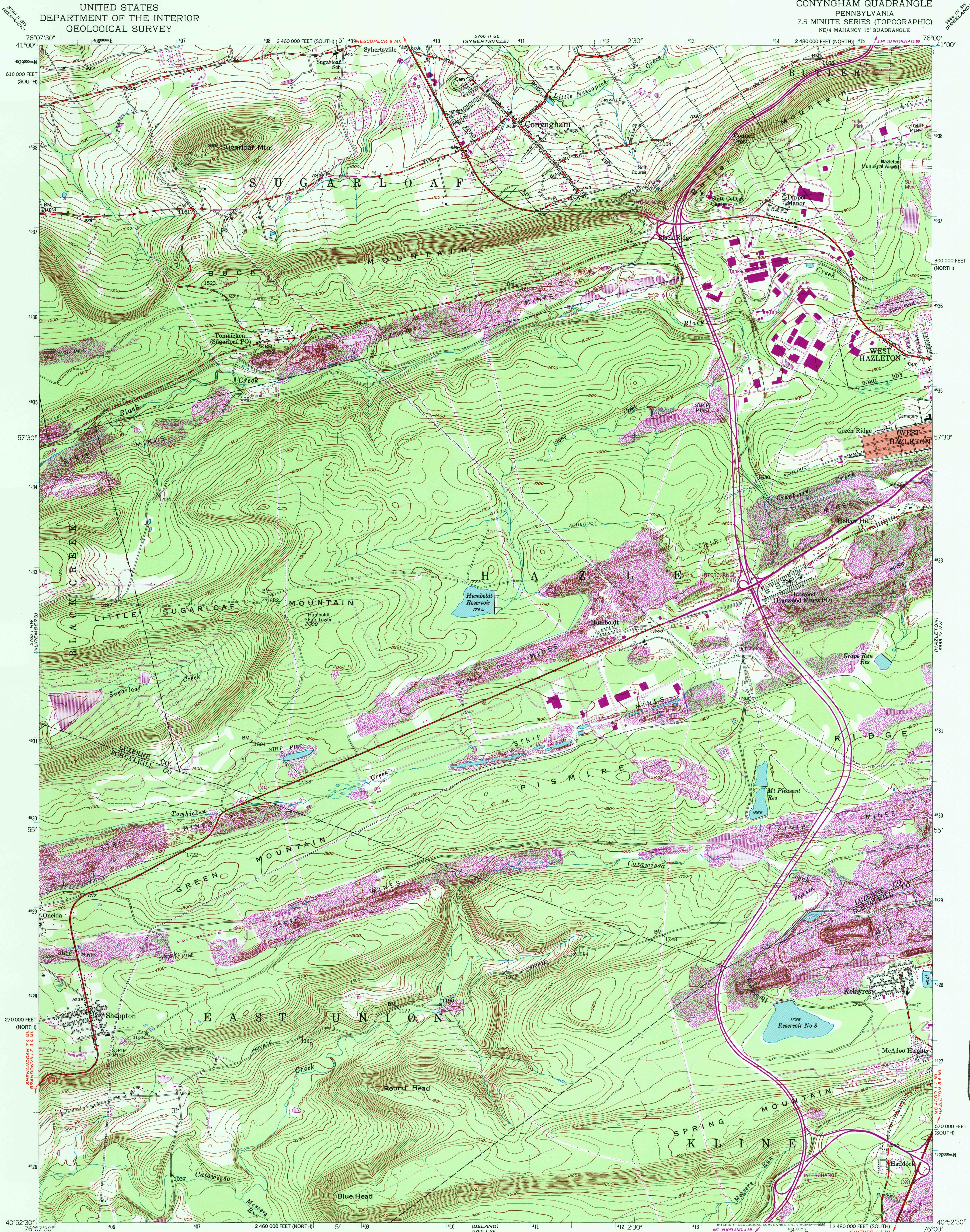

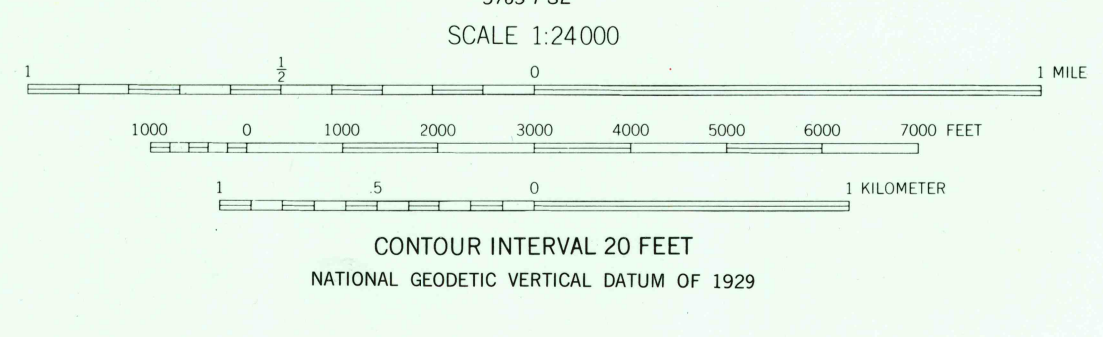
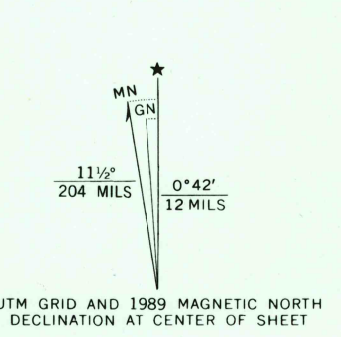
CONYNGHAM QUADRANGLE
