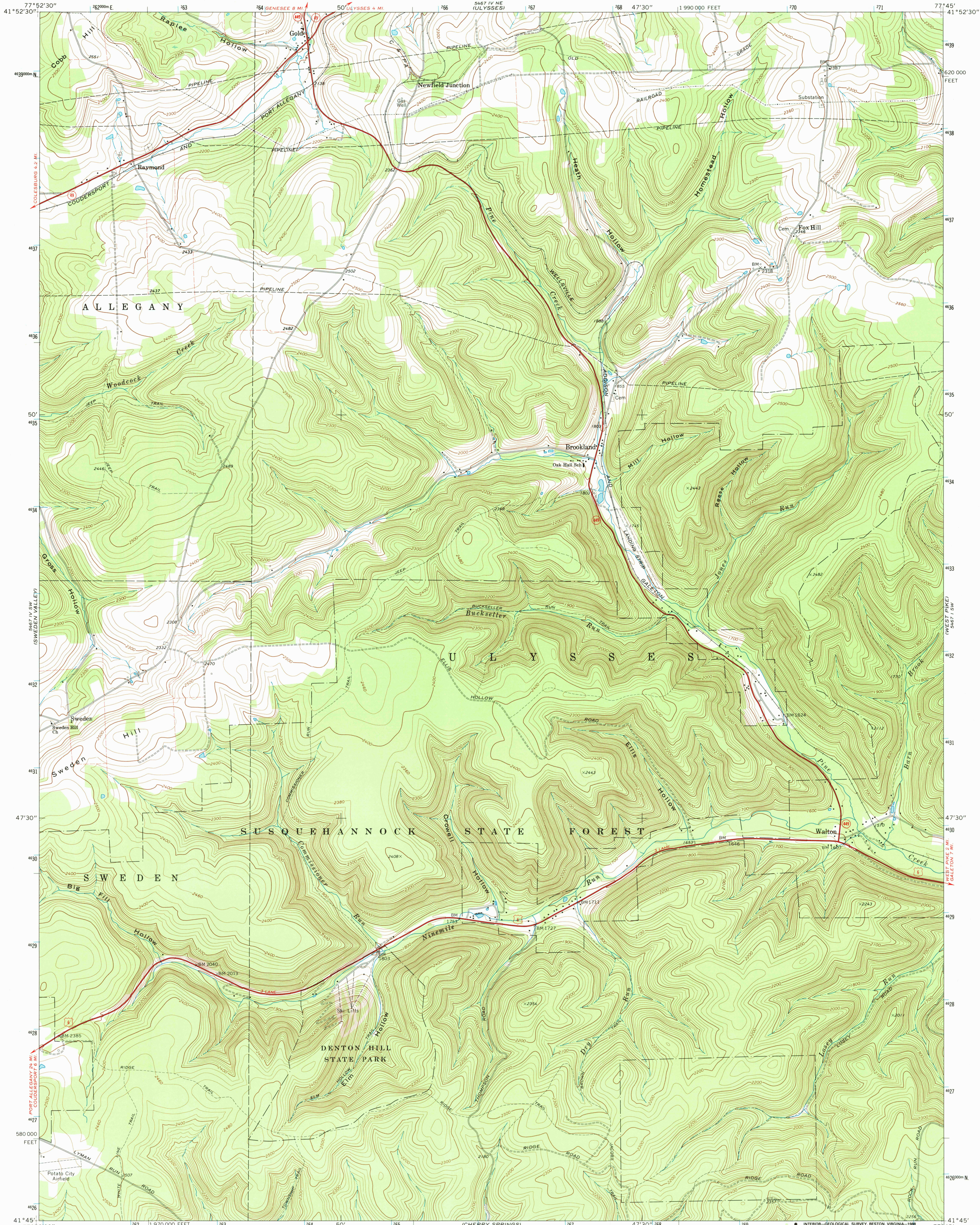

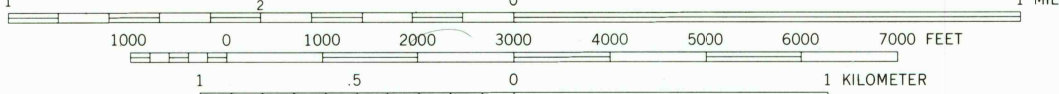
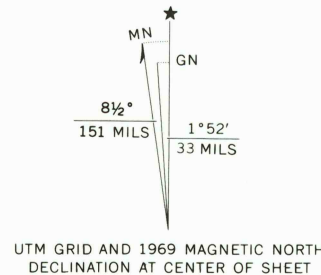

To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983, move the projection lines 3 meters south and 24 meters west as shown by dashed corner ticks
