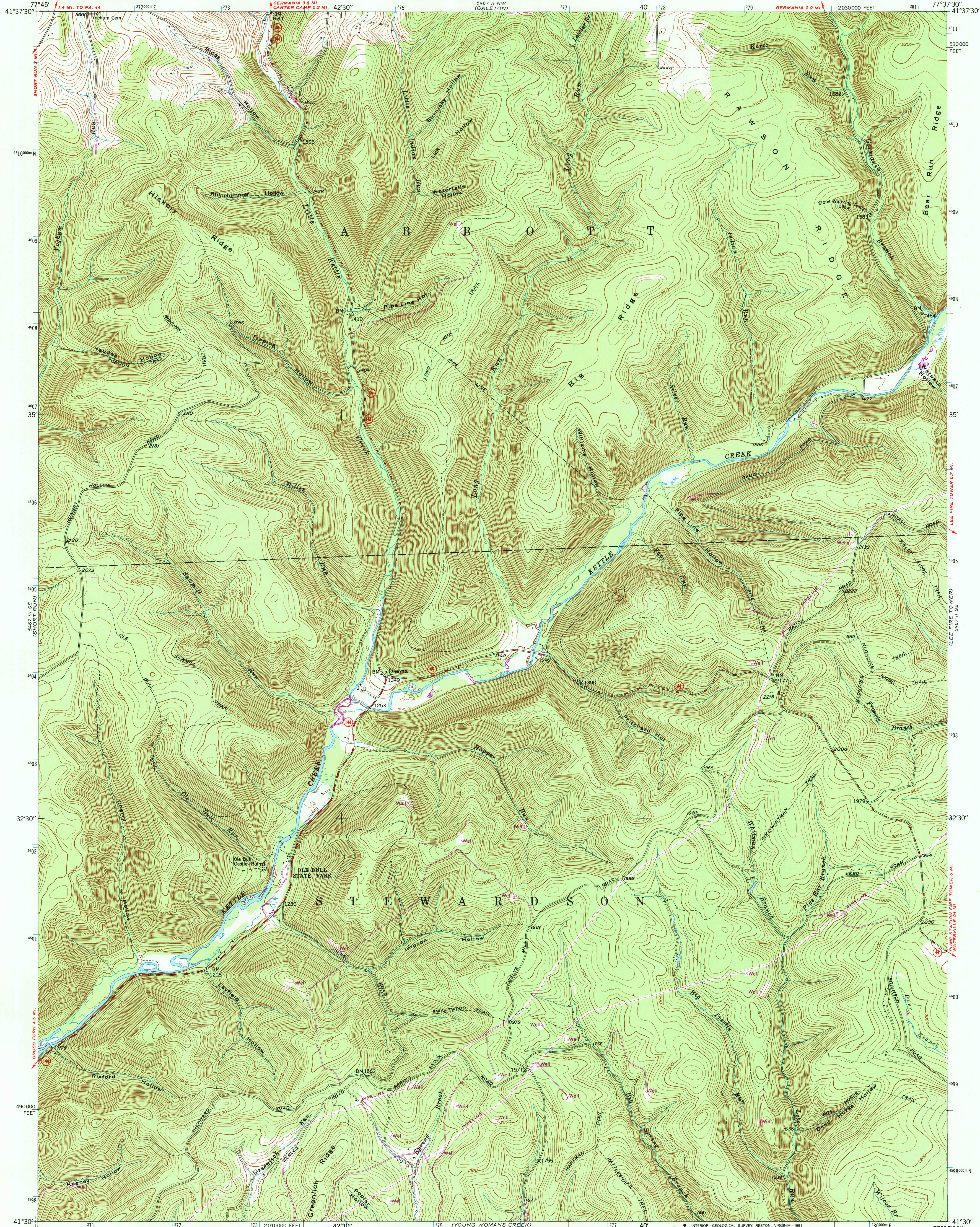

SW 1/4 GALETON 15' QUADRANGLE



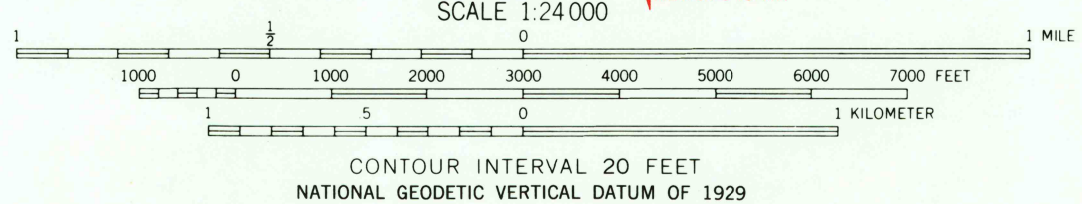
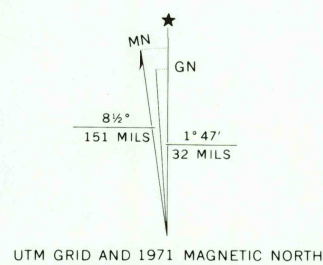
