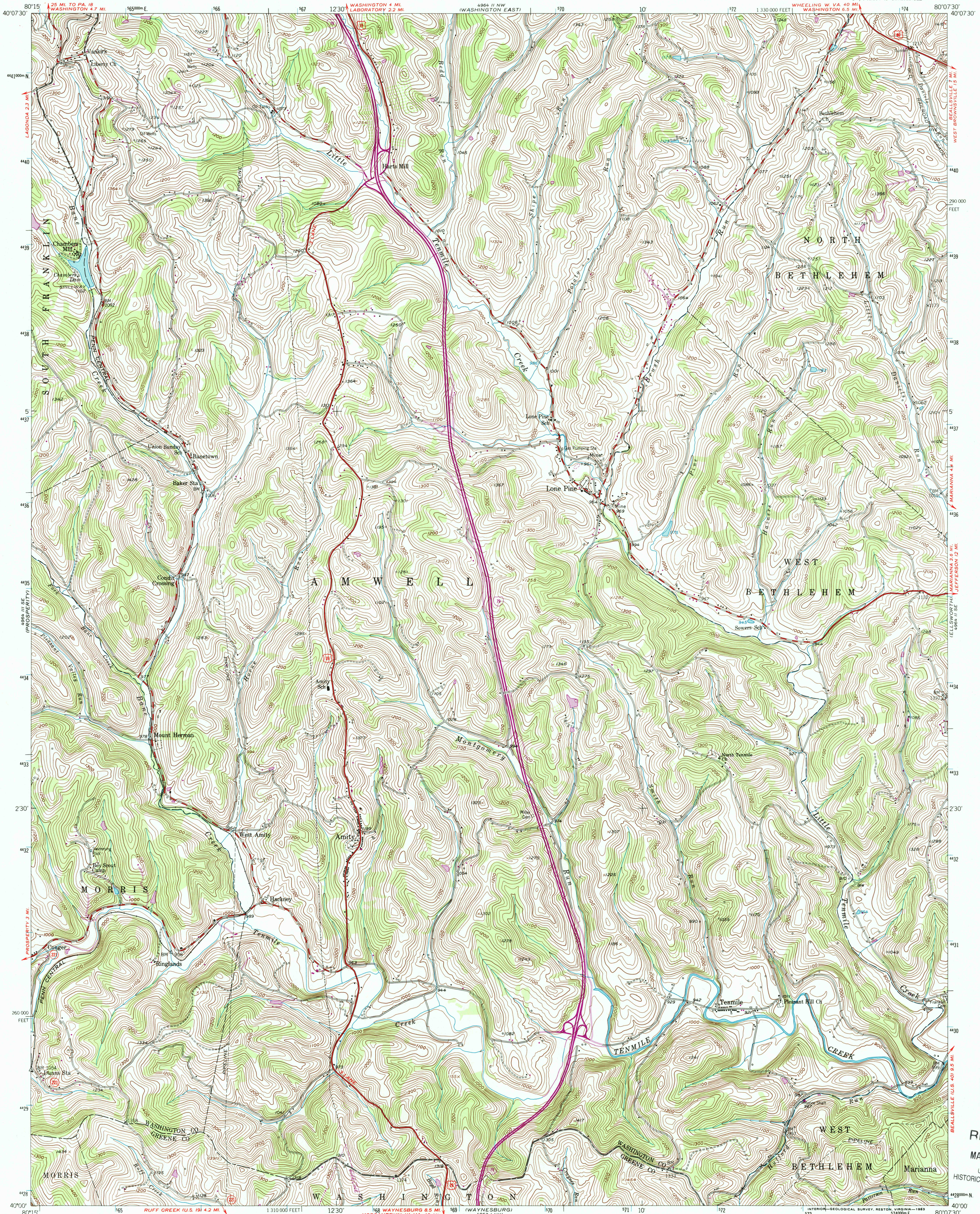

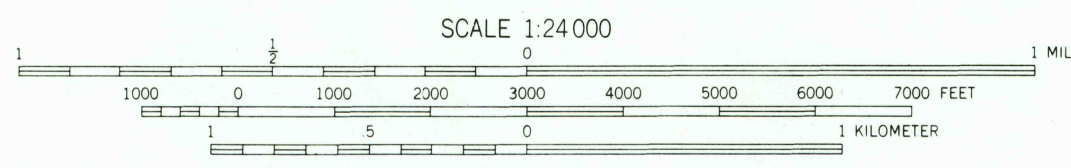
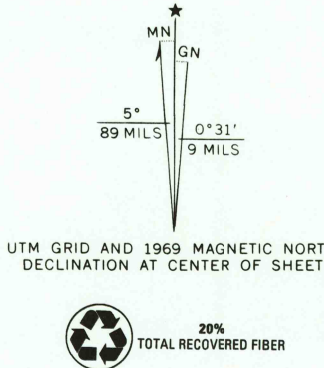

shown in blue

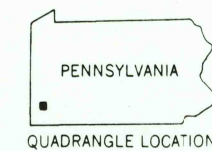
