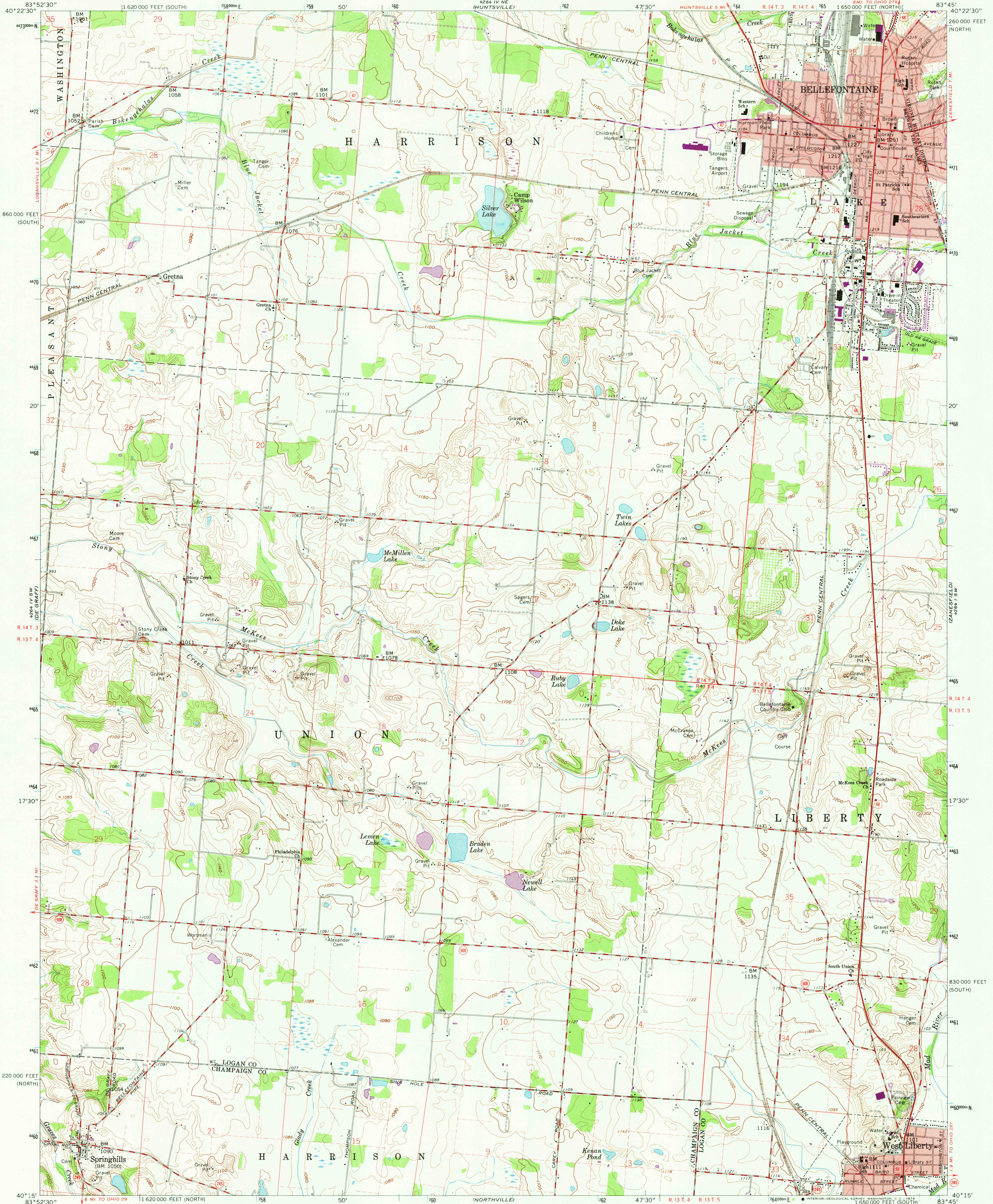

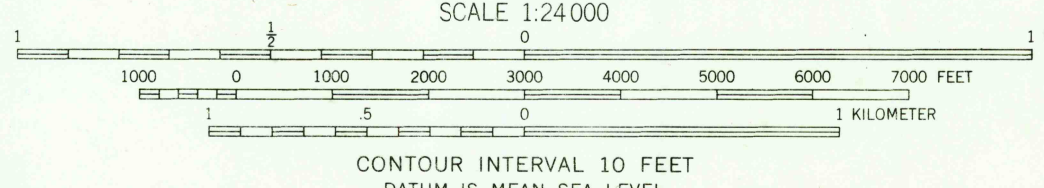
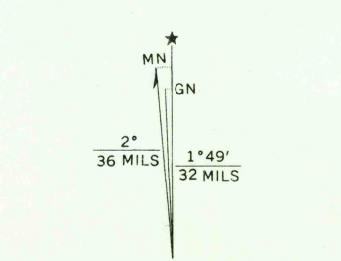
10,000-foot grids based on Ohio coordinate system, north and south zones
