

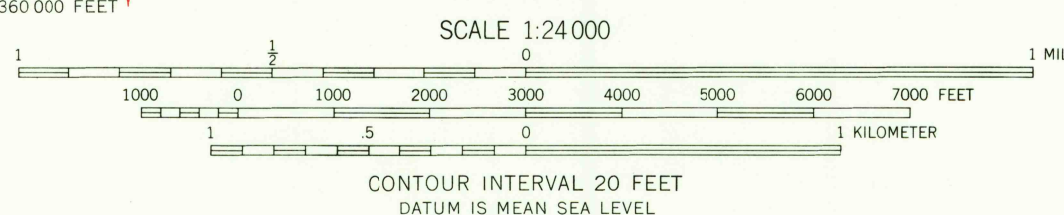

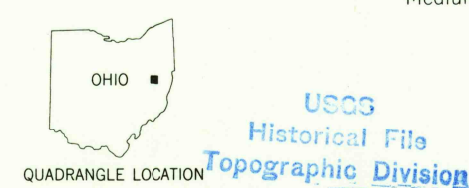

Polyconic projection. 1927 North American datum. 10,000-foot grid based on Ohio coordinate system, north zone. 1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 17, shown in blue. Entire area lies within the Old Seven Ranges. Land lines based on the Ohio River Base. Dotted land lines indicate private subdivision of the Dohrman Grant. Areas covered by dashed light-blue pattern are subject to controlled inundation. Fine red dashed lines indicate selected fence and field lines where generally visible on aerial photographs. This information is unchecked.
