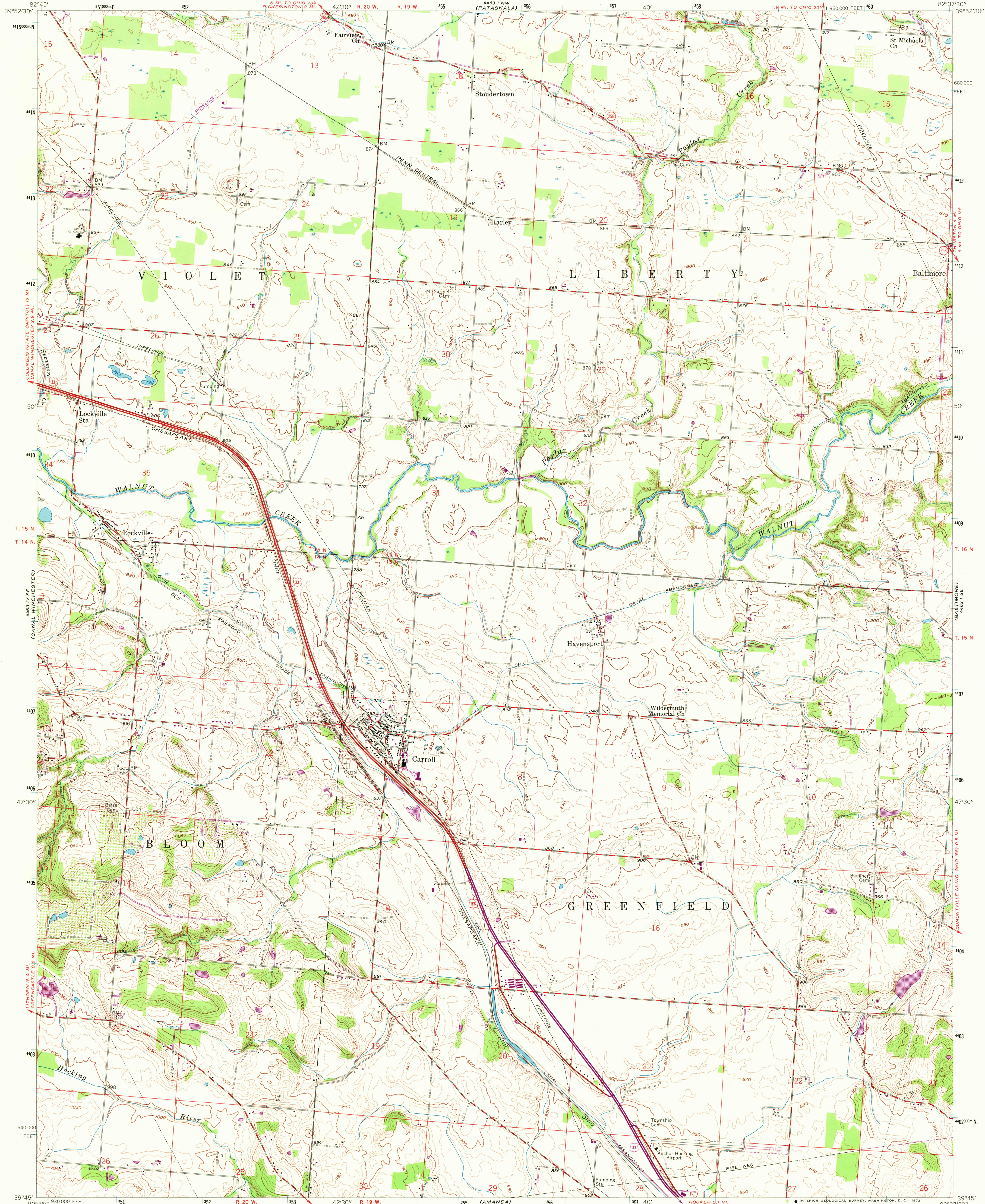

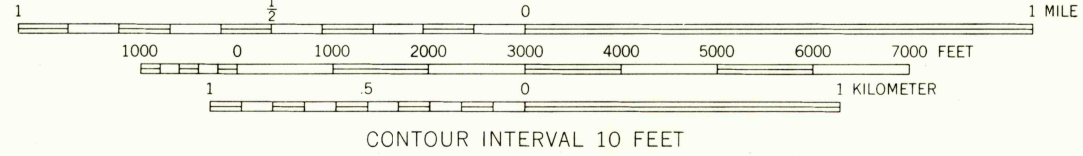
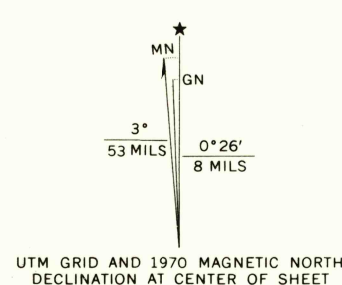
10,000-foot grid based on Ohio coordinate system, south zone
