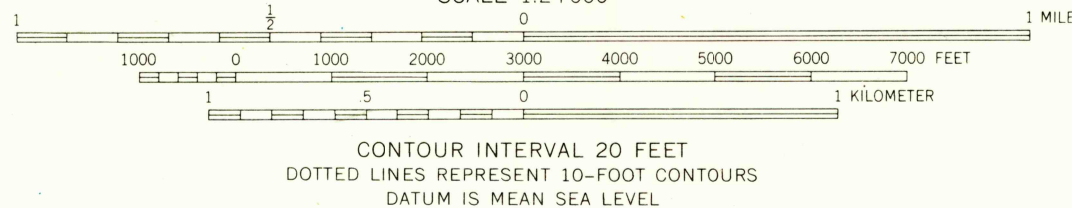
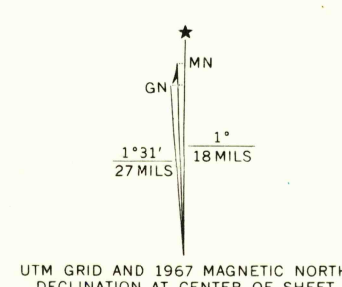

Fine red dashed lines indicate selected fence and field lines where generally visible on aerial photographs. This information is unchecked. The state boundary as shown represents the approximate position of the low water line as determined from U.S. Corps of Engineers Ohio River charts, surveyed 1913, and supplementary information. Ohio area lies within the Virginia Military District.
