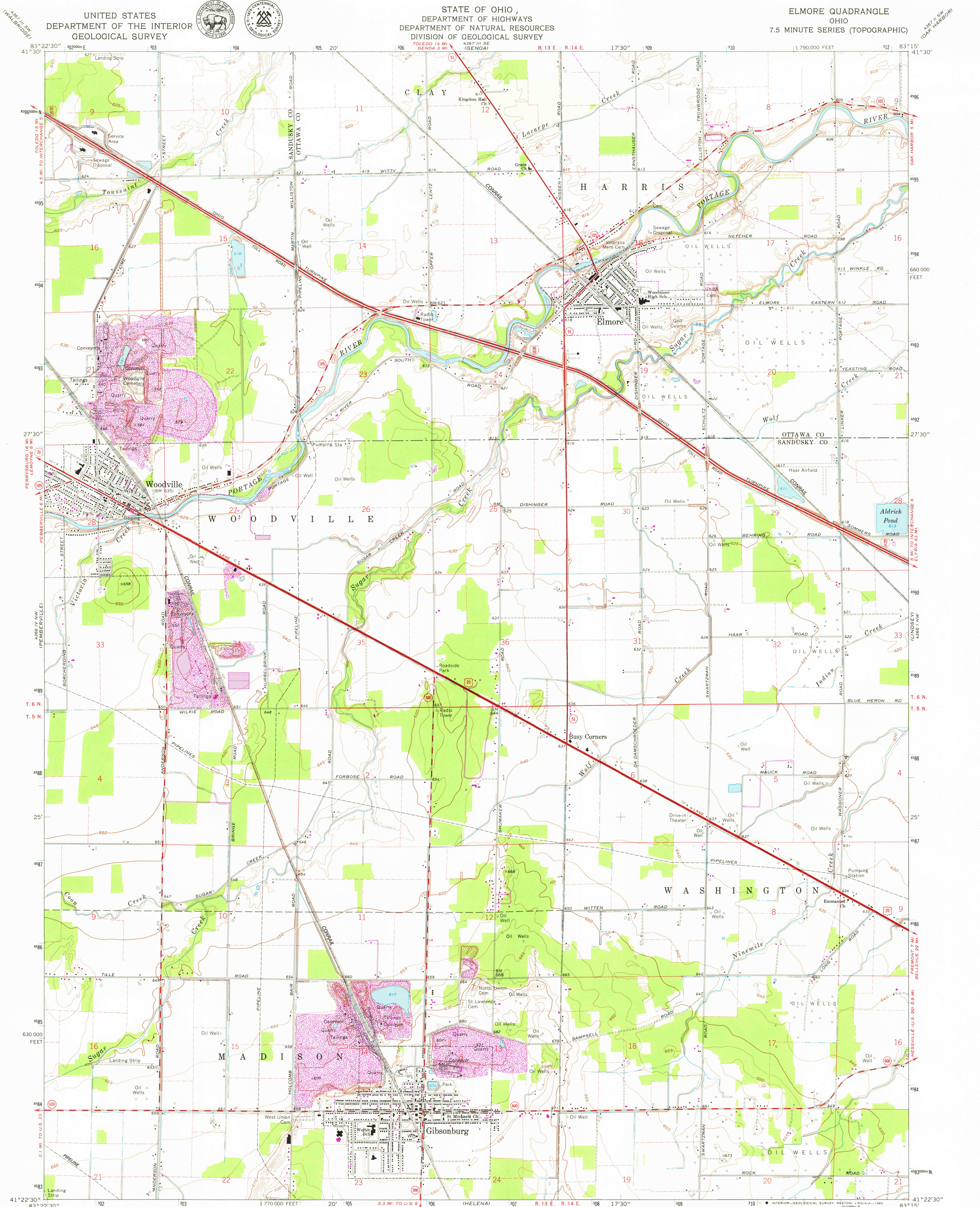

Fine red dashed lines indicate selected fence and field lines where generally visible on aerial photographs. This information is unchecked
Entire area lies within the Congress Lands
Land lines based on the First Principal Meridian
