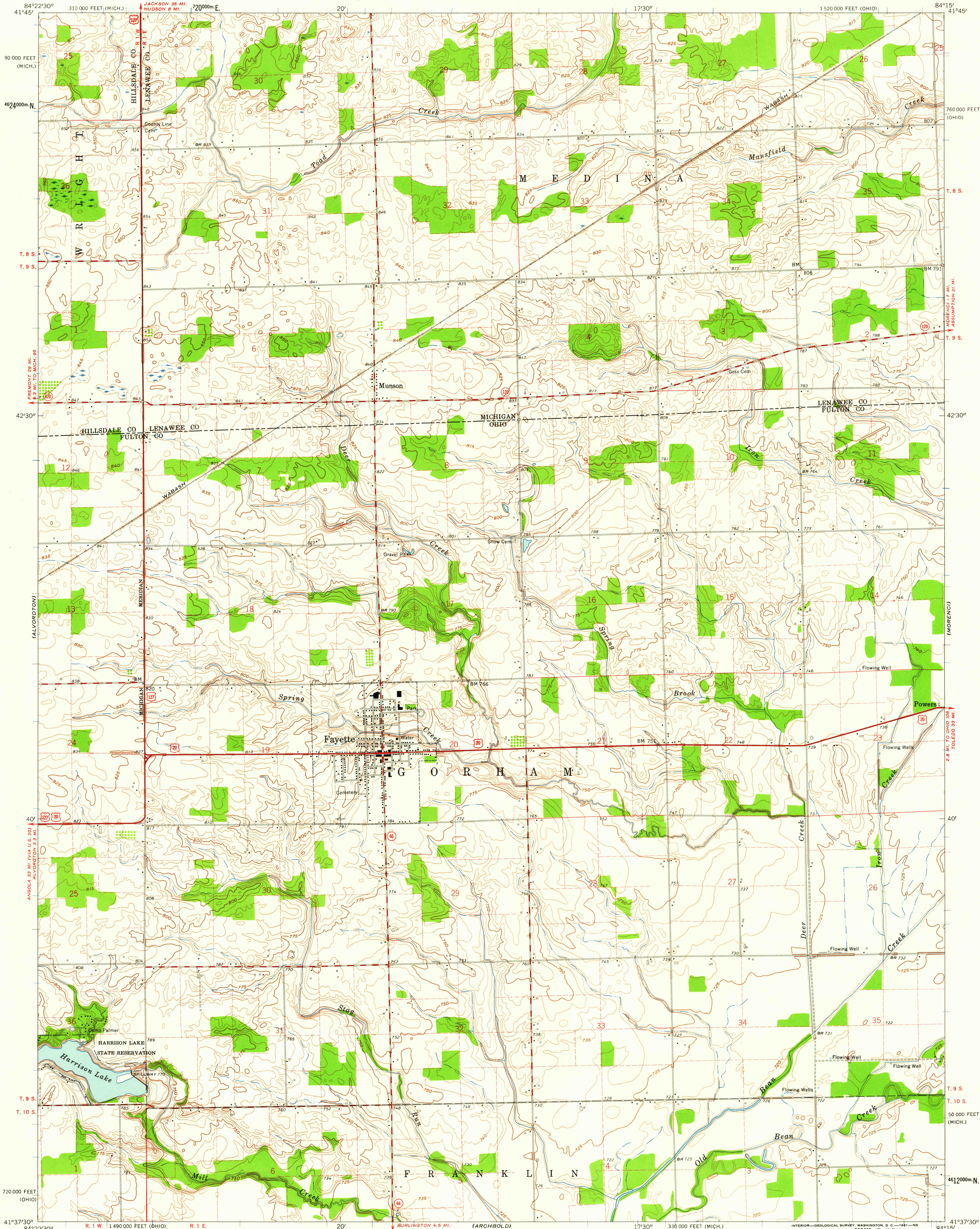

and Michigan coordinate system, east zone

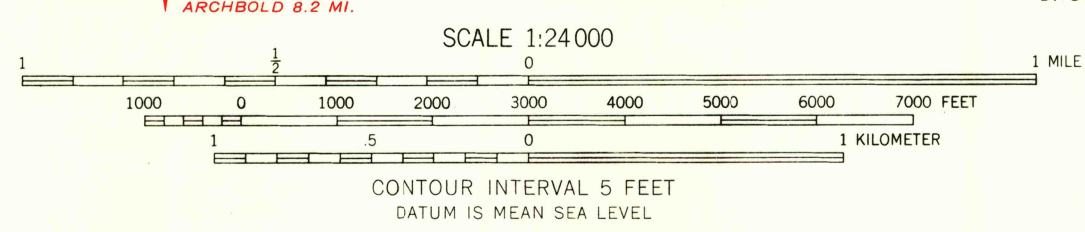
1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks,
