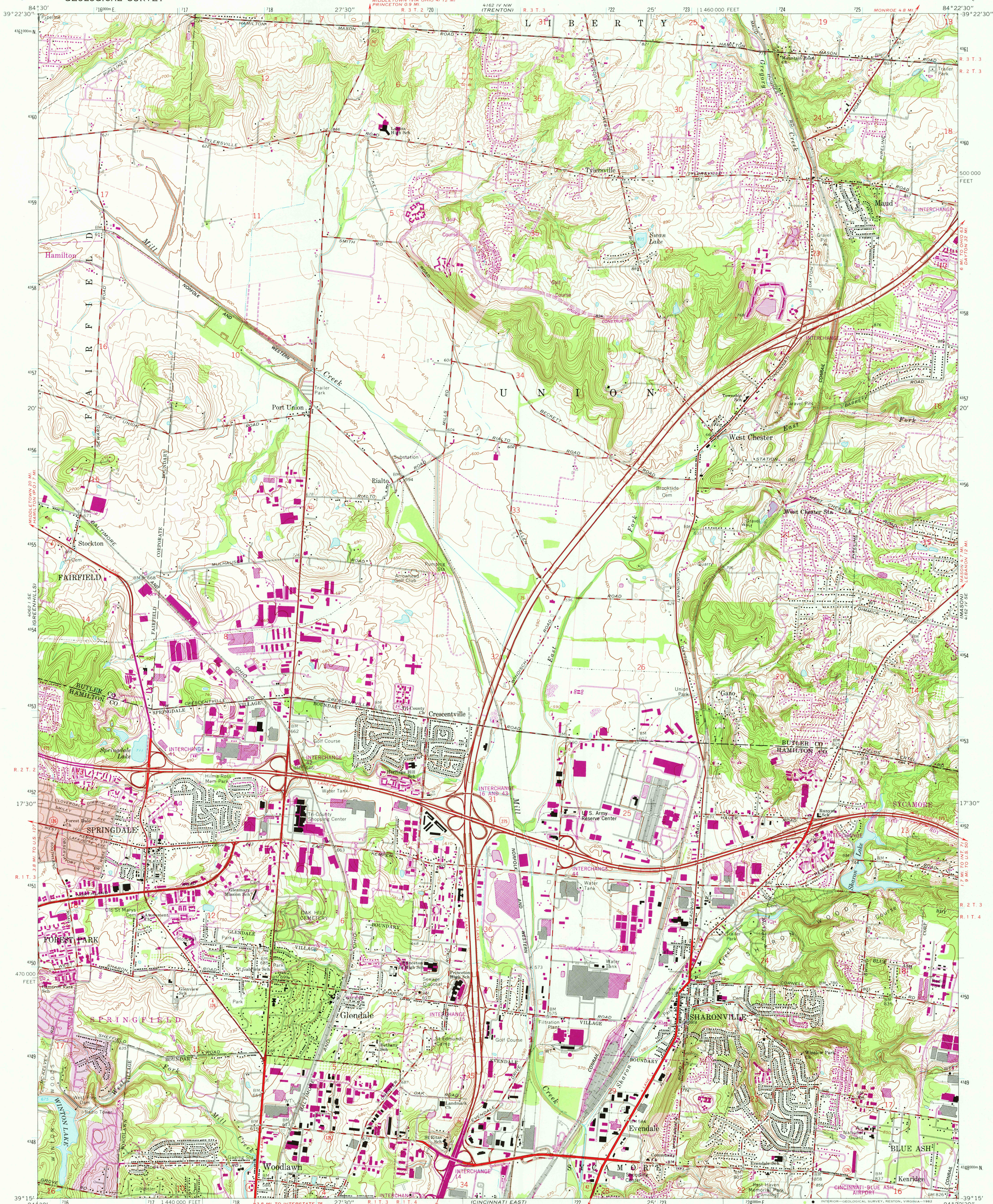


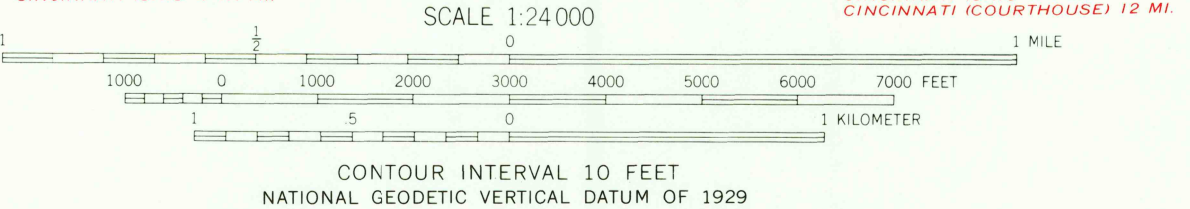

coordinate system, south zone. 1000-meter Universal  
Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 16, shown in blue  
1927 North American Datum. To place on the predicted North  
American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 3 meters  
south and 6 meters west as shown by dashed corner ticks  
Fine red dashed lines indicate selected fence and field lines where  
generally visible on aerial photographs. This information is unchecked  
Red tint indicates areas in which only landmark buildings are shown  
Entire area lies within the Between the Miamis. Land lines based on  
the Great Miami River Base. Dotted land lines established by private  
subdivision of the Symmes Purchase  
There may be private inholdings within the boundaries of the  
National or State reservations shown on this map
