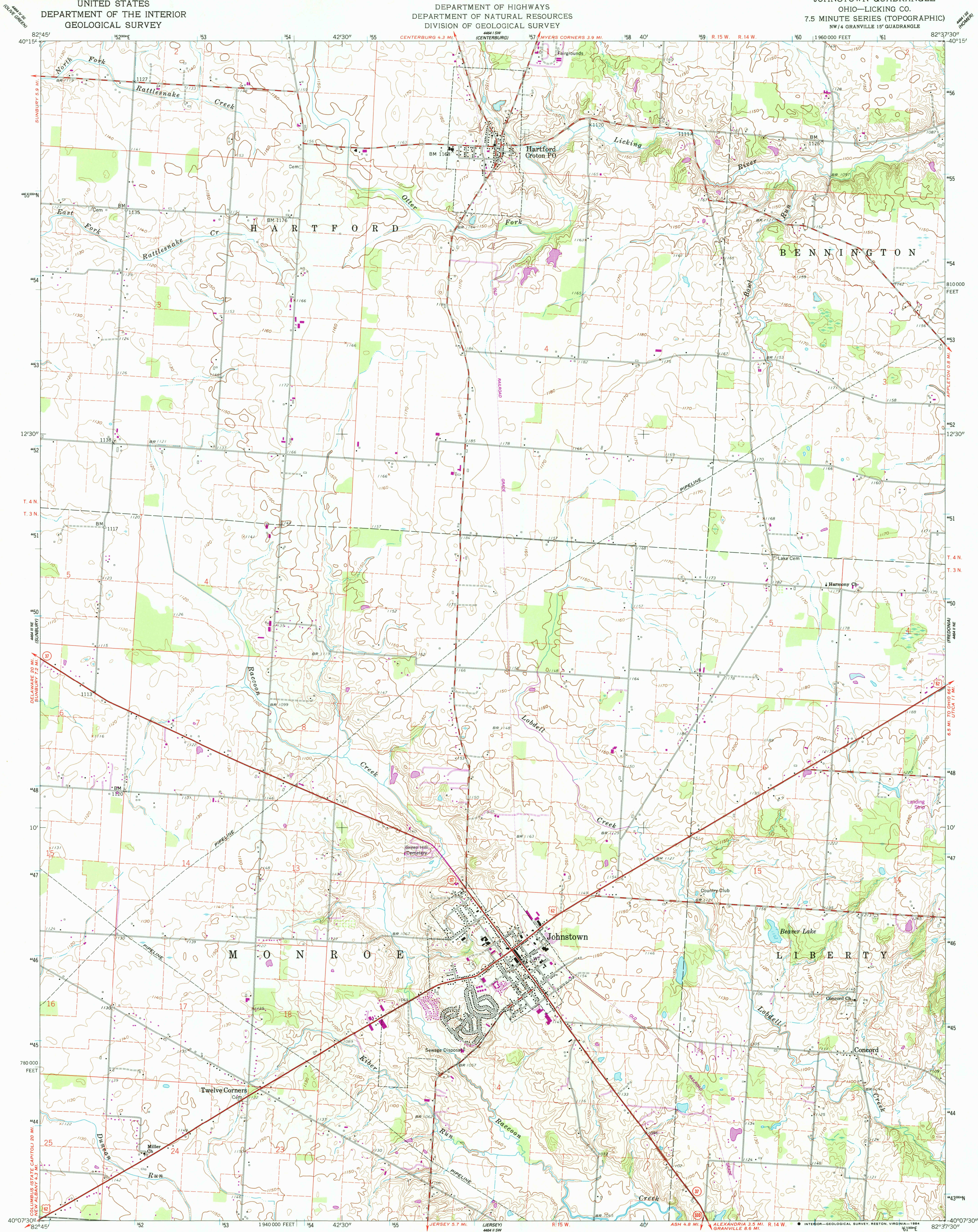

move the projection lines 3 meters south and

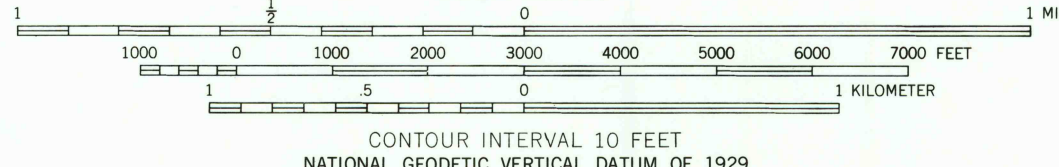
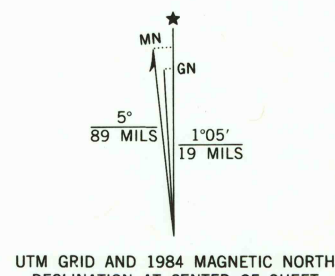
10 meters west as shown by dashed corner ticks
