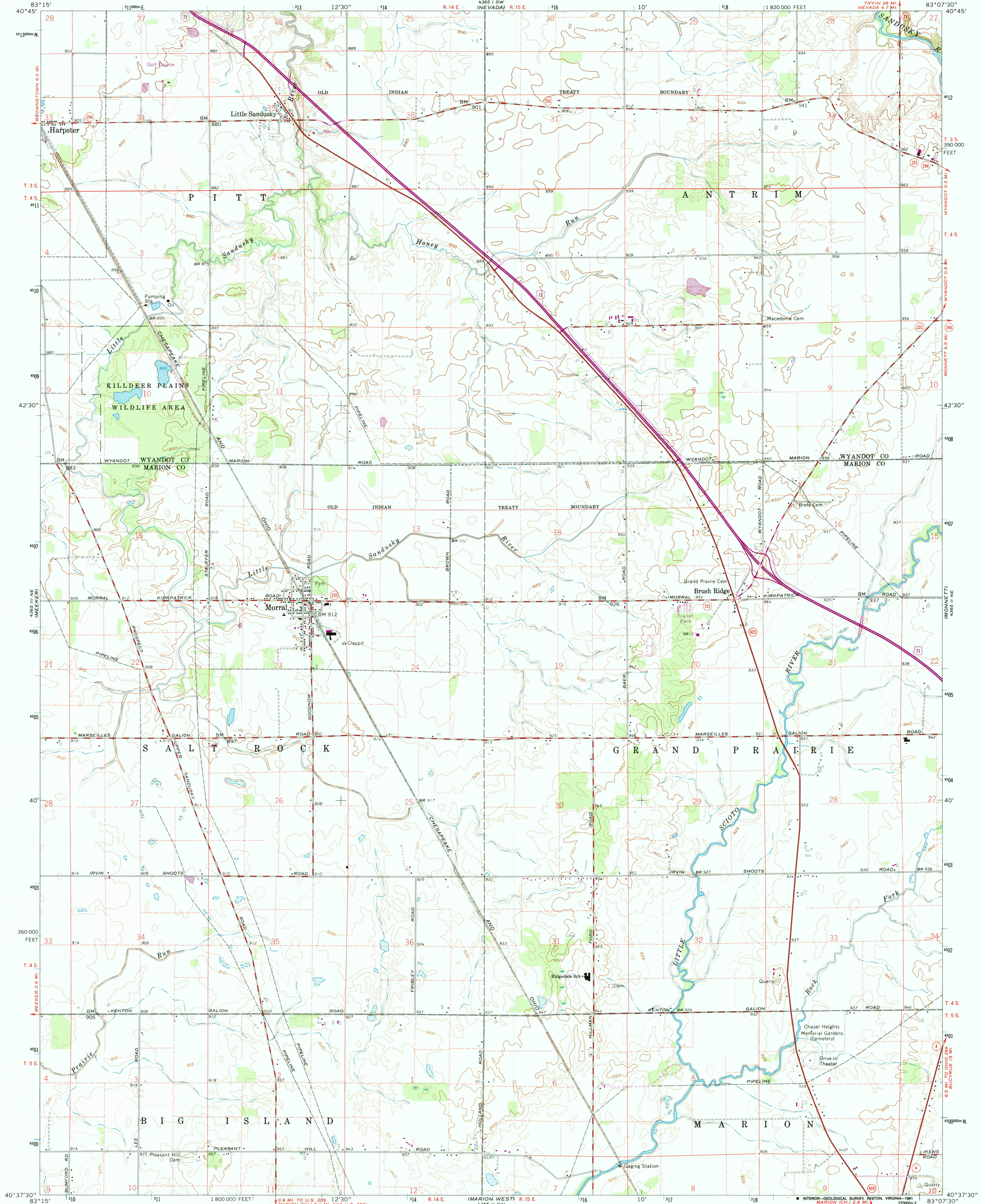

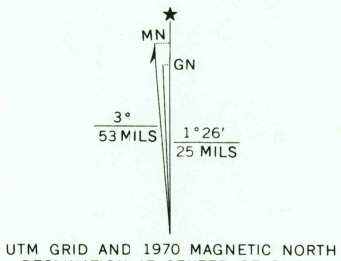

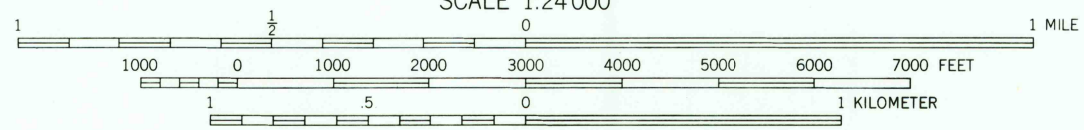
Entire area lies within Congress Lands

Land lines based on the First Principal Meridian

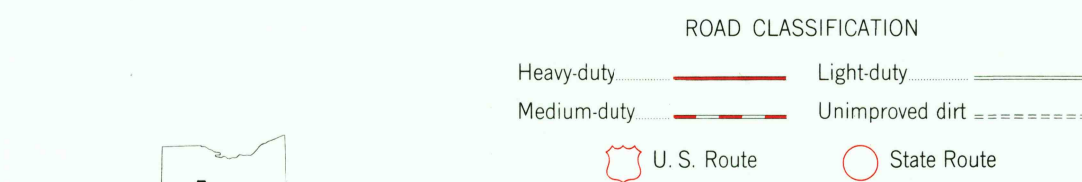
