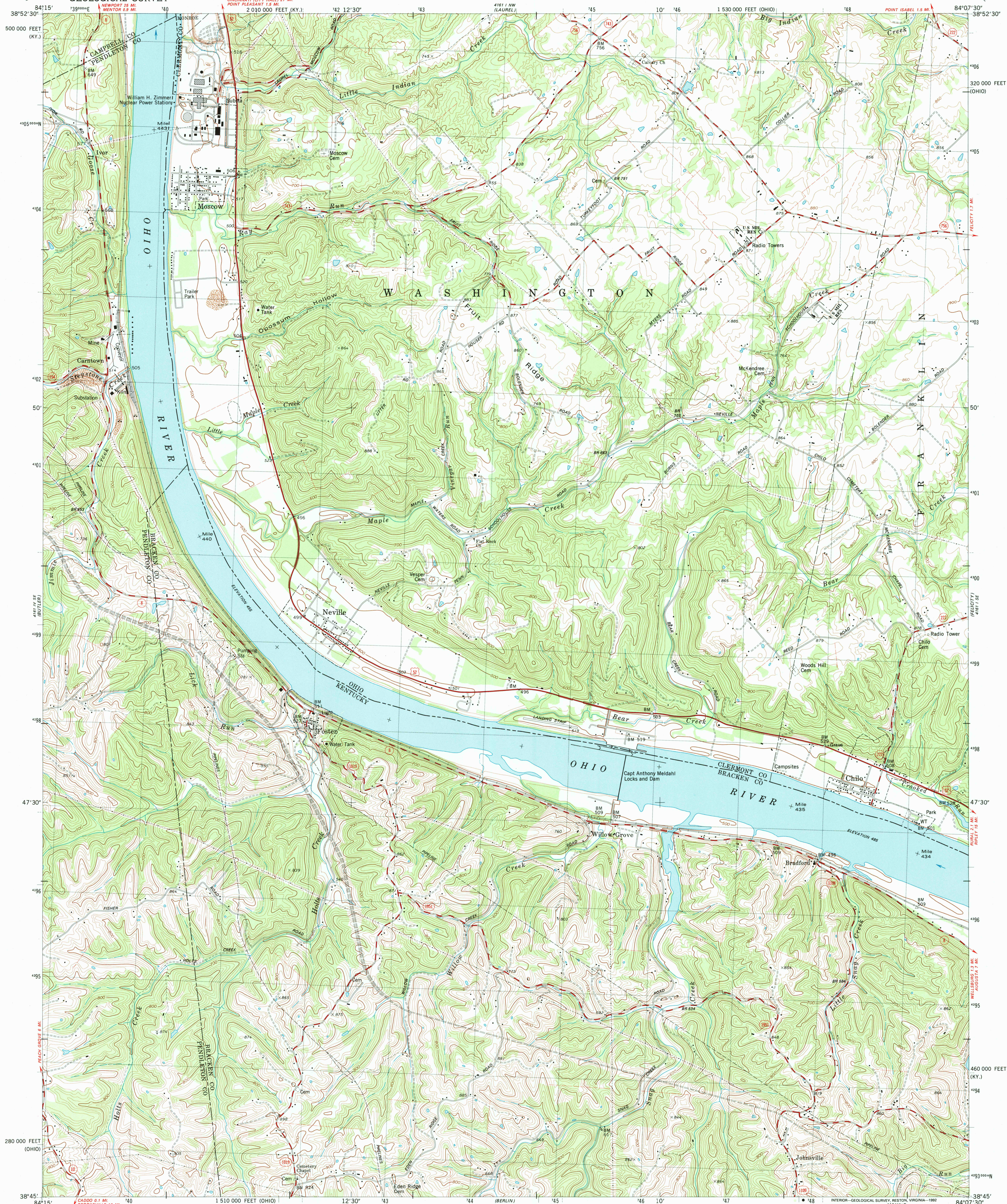
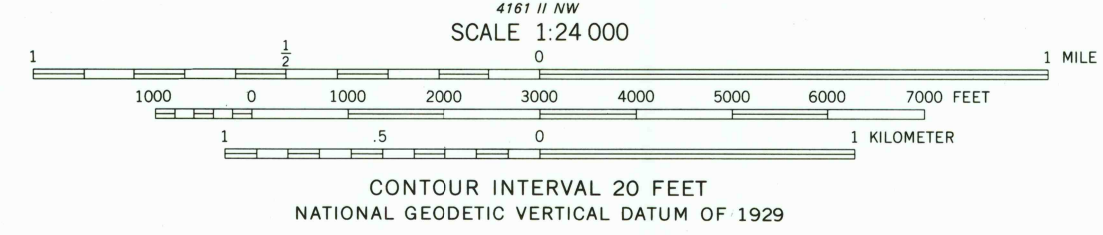
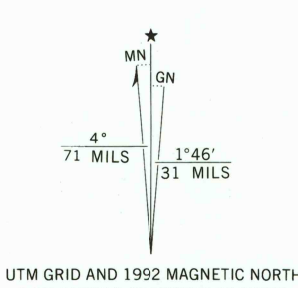

The NAD 83 is shown by dashed corner ticks The state boundary as shown represents the approximate position of the low water line as determined from U.S. Corps of Engineers Ohio River charts, surveyed 1913-1914, and supplementary information Ohio area lies within the Virginia Military District
