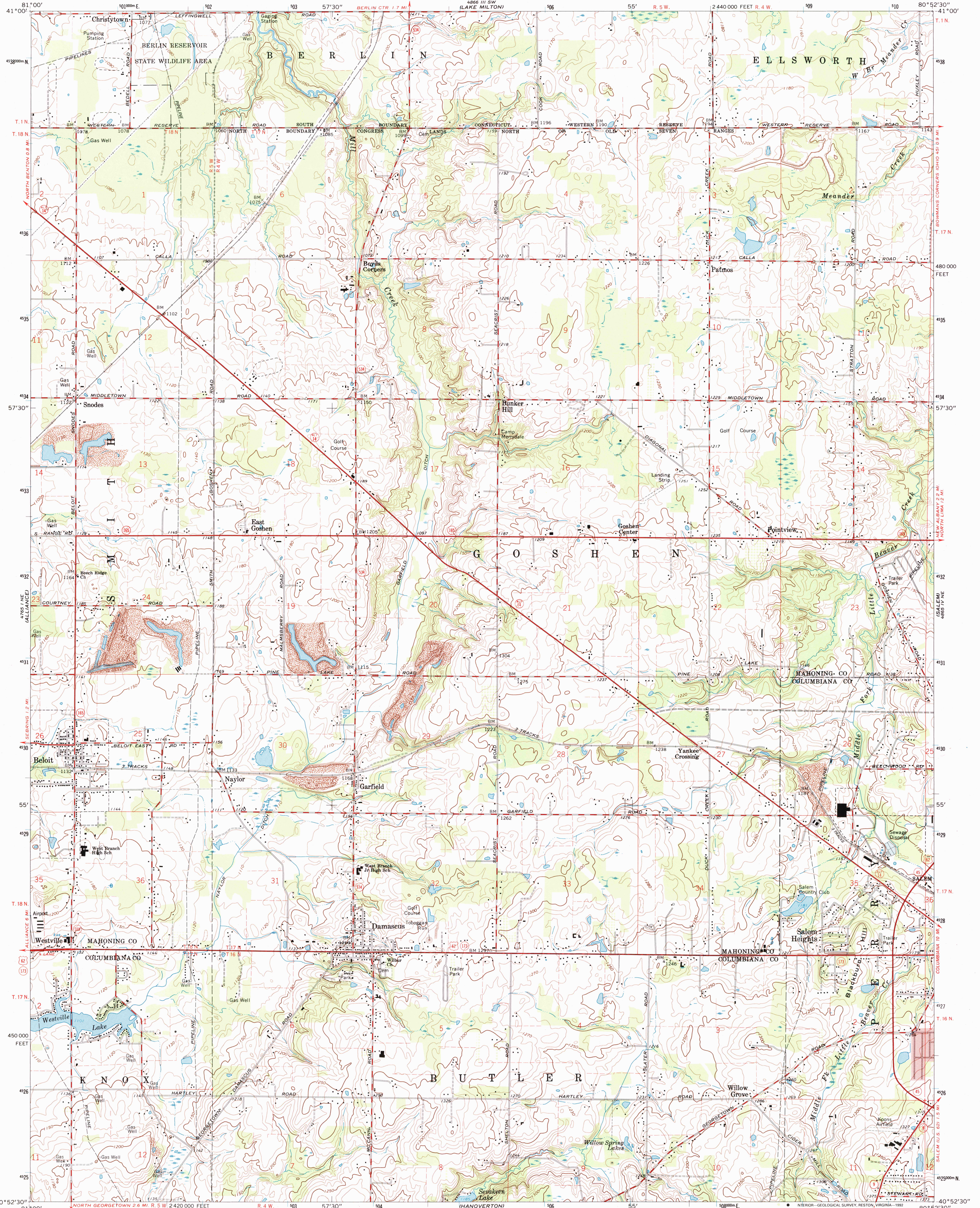

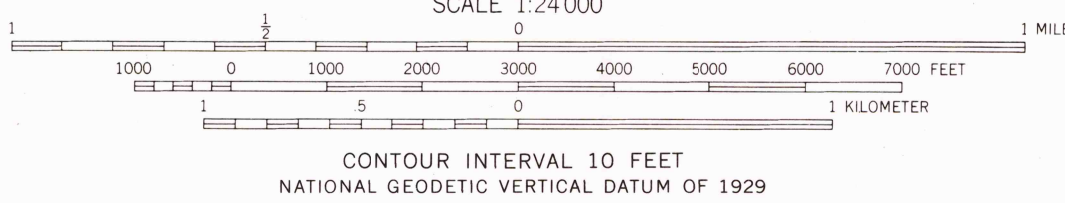
DAMASCUS QUADRANGLE
