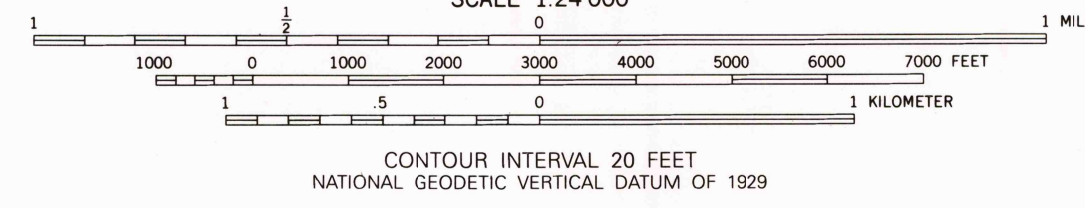
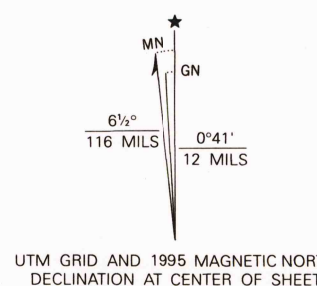

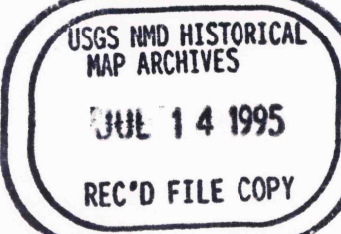
DEAVERTOWN QUADRANGLE
