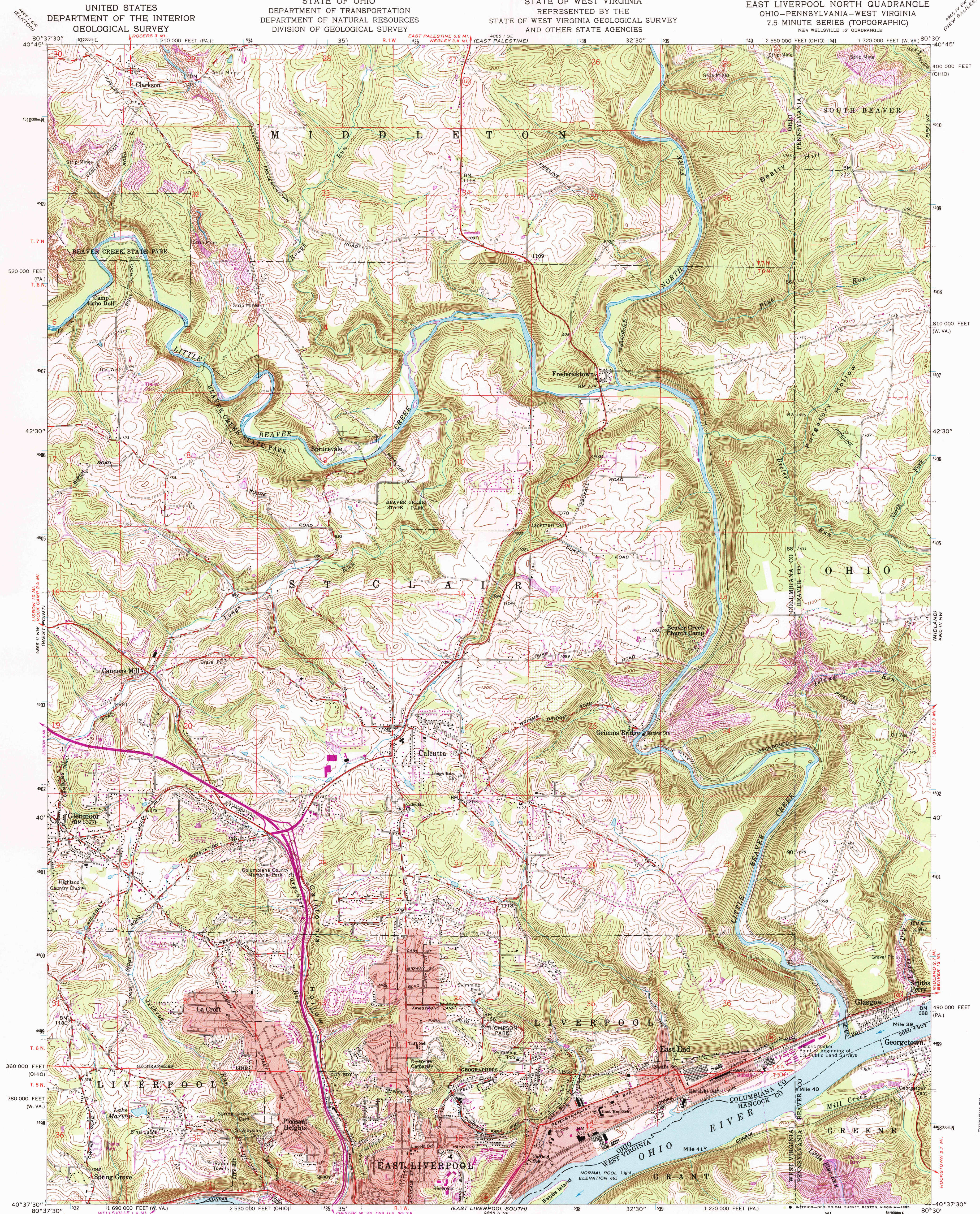

To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983
move the projection lines 2 meters south and
16 meters west as shown by dashed corner ticks.
Red tint indicates areas in which only landmark buildings are shown.
The Ohio-W. Va. boundary as shown represents the approximate position
of the low water line as determined from U. S. Corps of Engineers Ohio
River Charts, surveyed 1913, and supplementary information.
Area north of Geographers Line lies within Congress Lands north of the
Old Seven Ranges. Area south of Geographers Line lies within the Old
Seven Ranges. Land lines based on the Ohio River Base.
There may be private inholdings within the boundaries of
the National or State reservations shown on this map.
