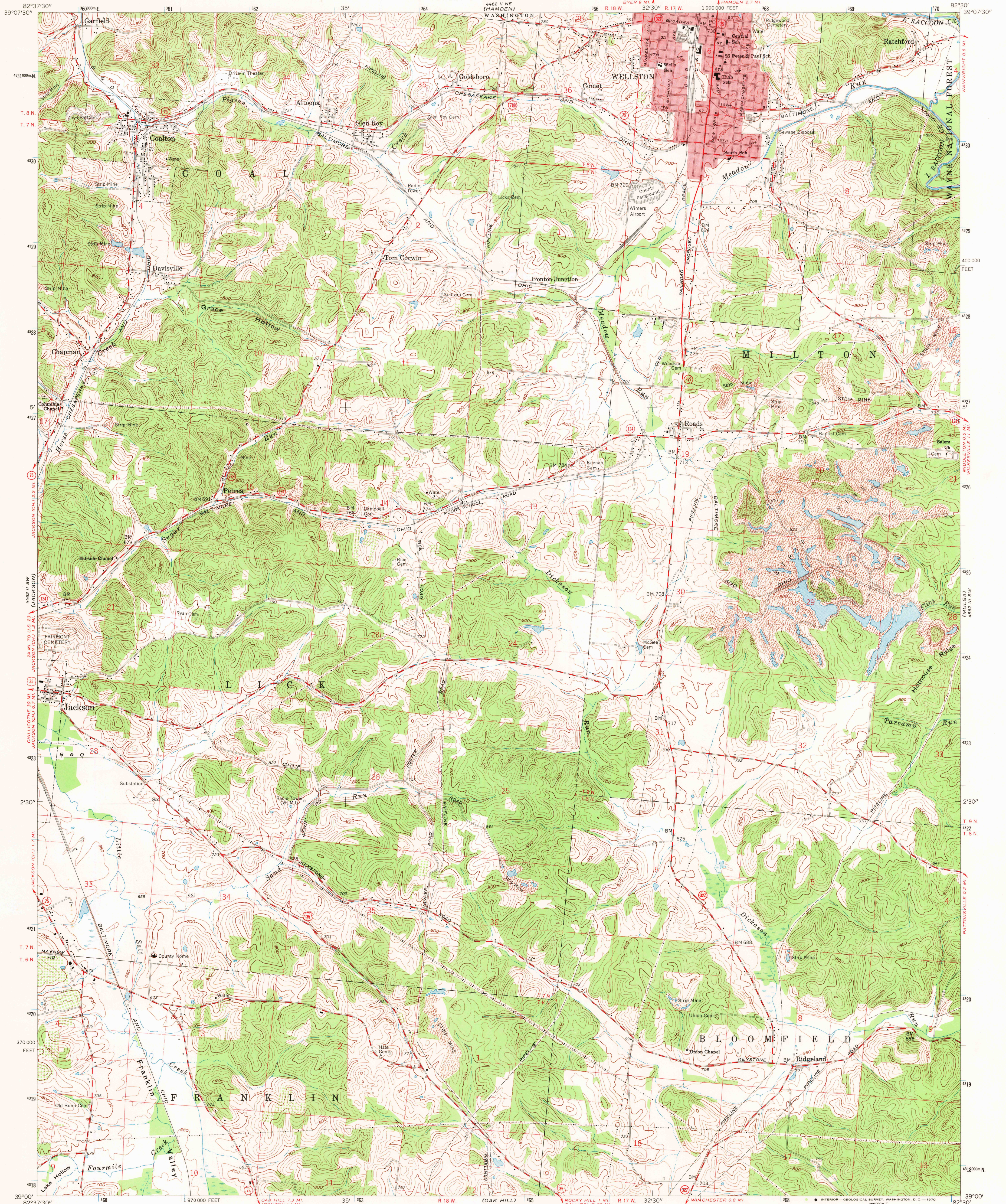

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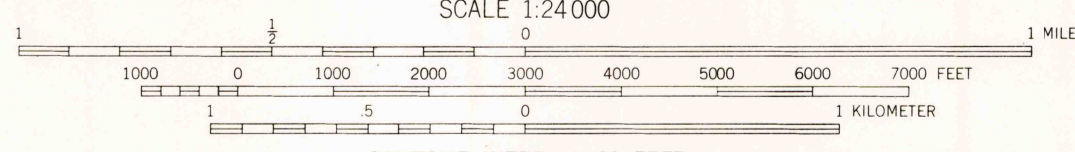
Topography by photogrammetric methods from aerial photographs taken 1960. Field checked 1961
