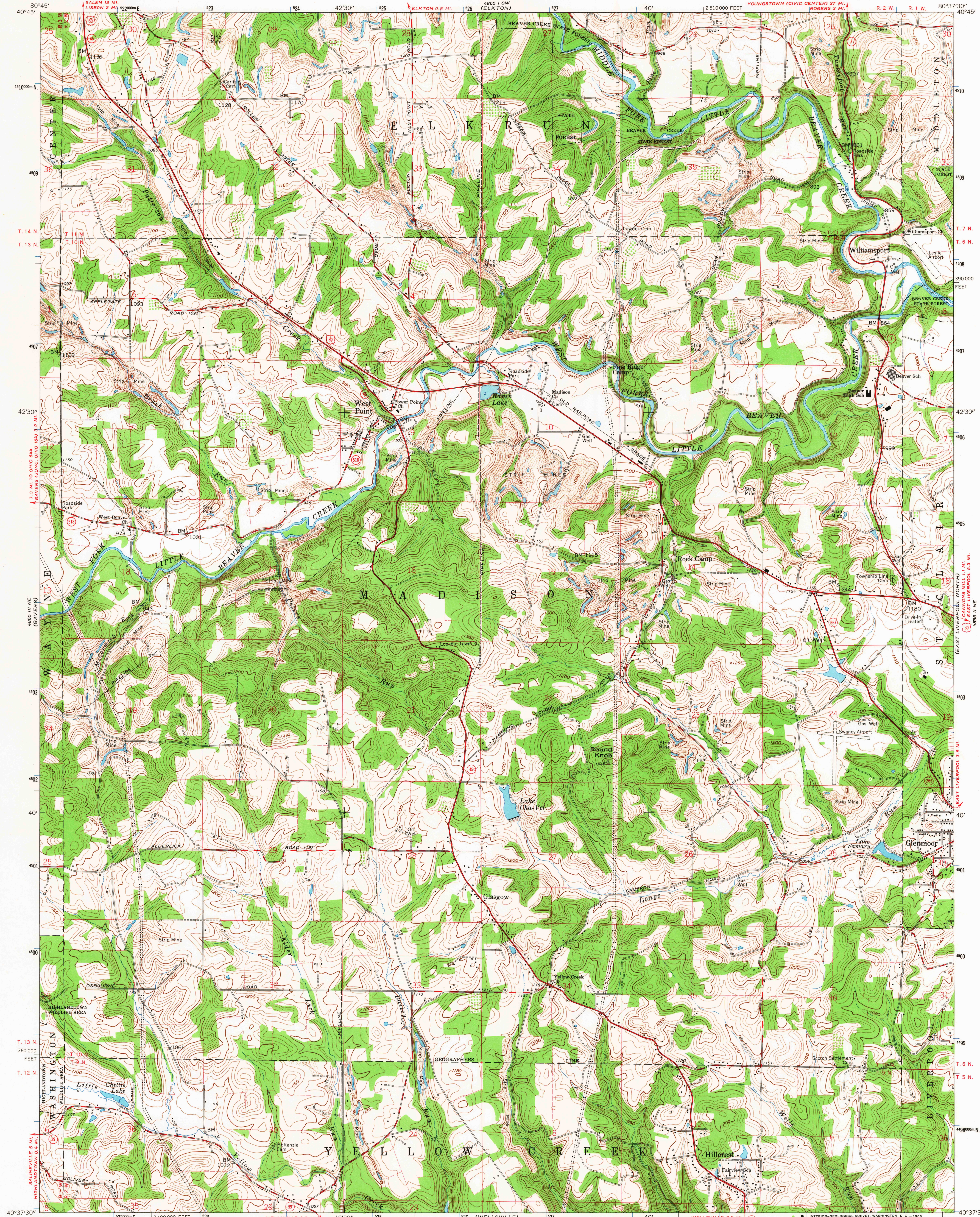

10,000-foot grid based on Ohio coordinate system, north zone

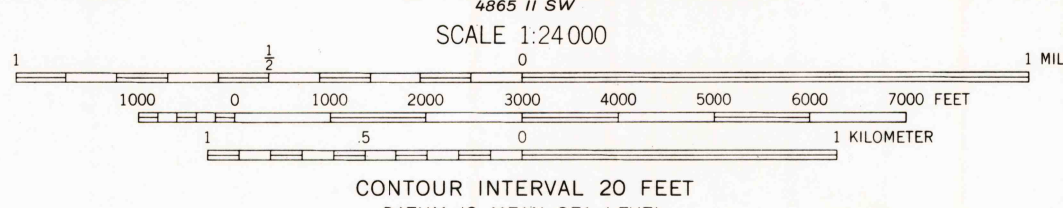
1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 17, shown in blue

Fine red dashed lines indicate selected fence and field lines where generally visible on aerial photographs. This information is unchecked

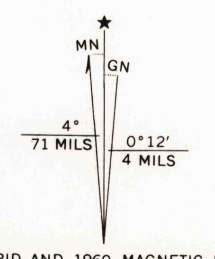
Area north of the Geographers Line lies within Congress Lands north of the Old Seven Ranges
