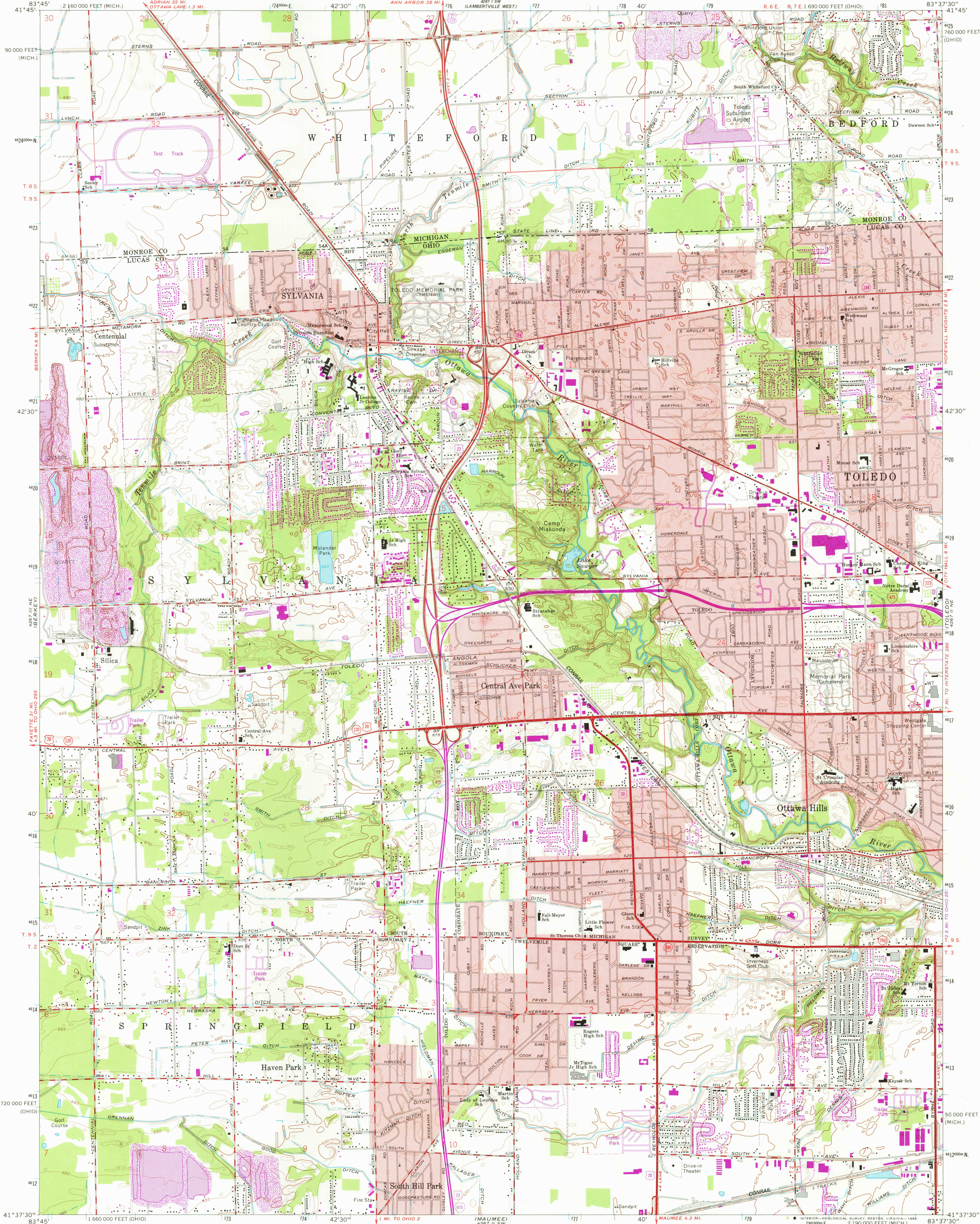

Fine red dashed lines indicate selected fence and field lines where generally visible on aerial photographs. This information not checked Red tint indicates areas in which only landmark buildings are shown Land lines within the Michigan Survey based on the Michigan Meridian
