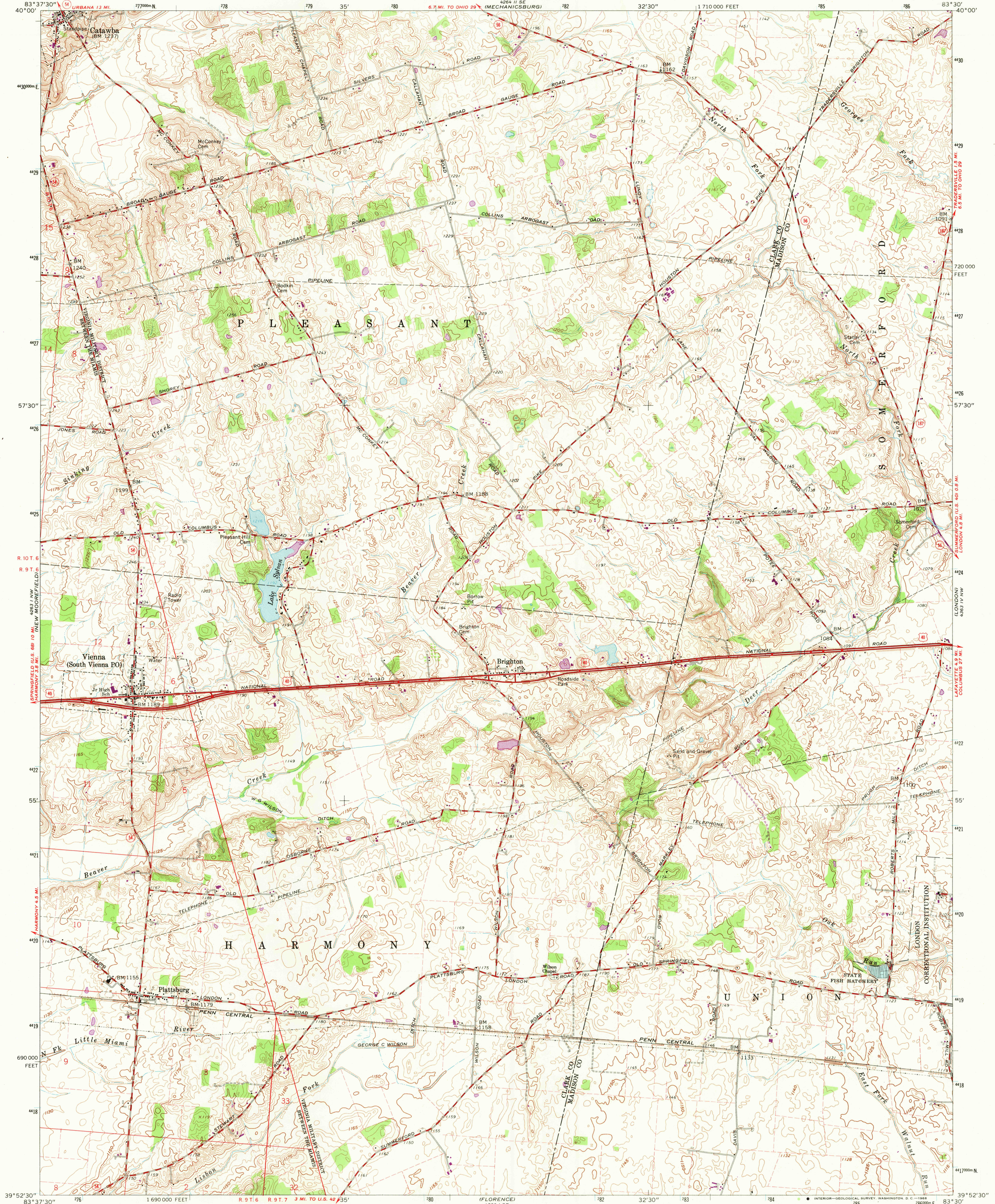

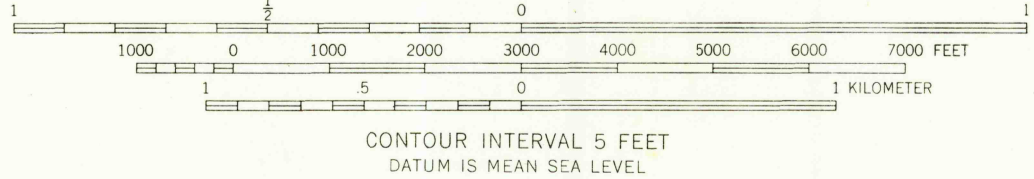
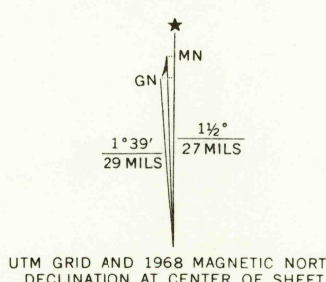
Topography by photogrammetric methods from aerial photographs taken 1959 and 1960. Field checked 1961
