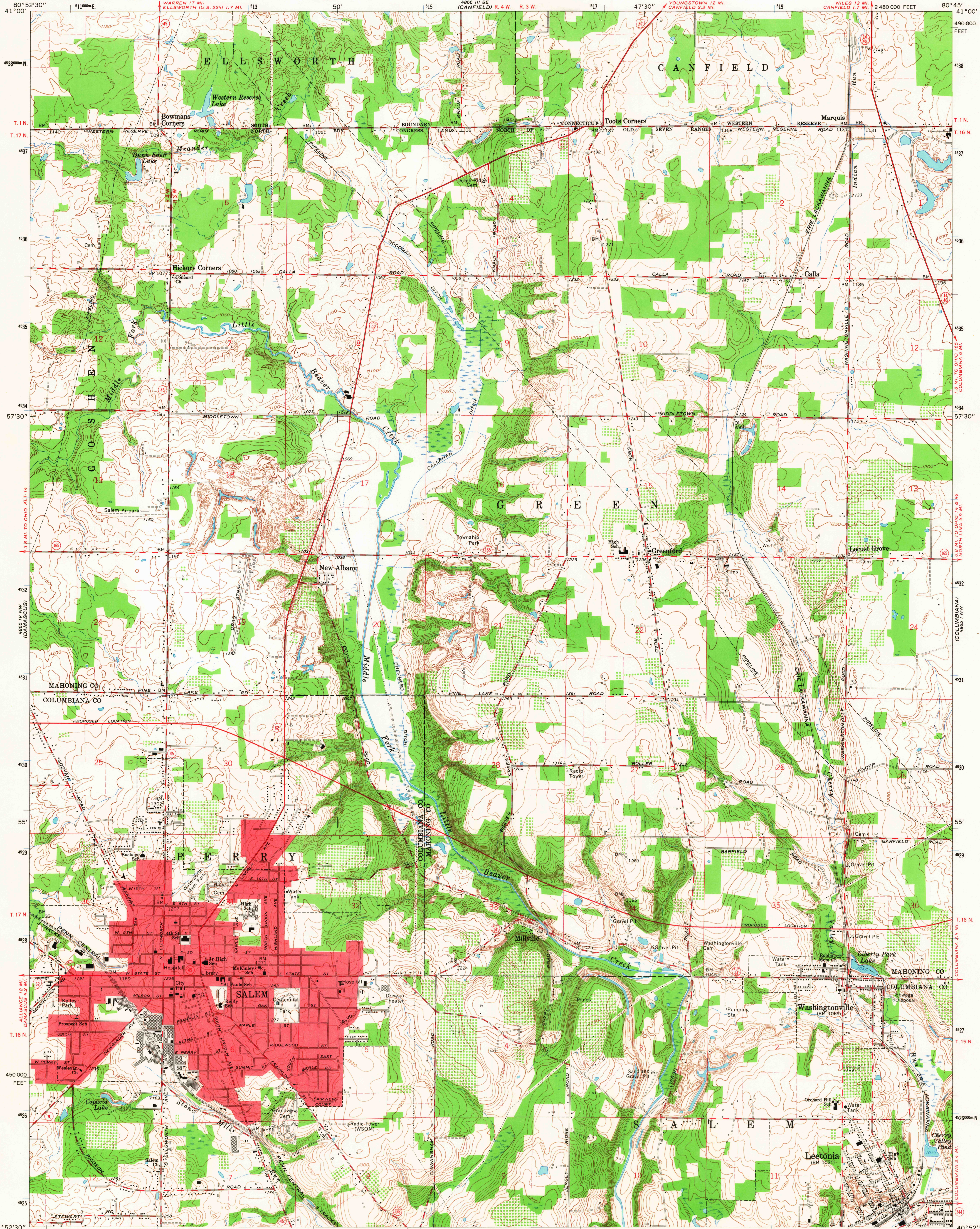
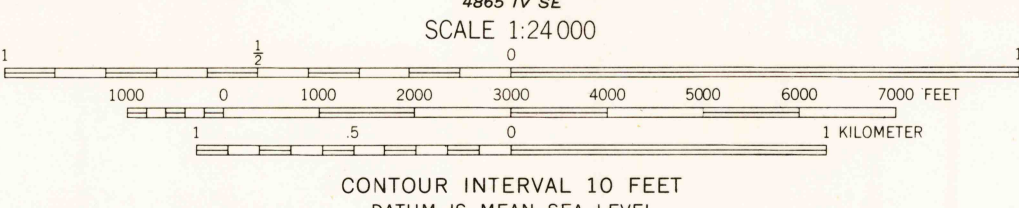

Polyconic projection. 1927 North American datum. 10,000-foot grid based on Ohio coordinate system, north zone 1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 17, shown in blue. Fine red dashed lines indicate selected fence and field lines where generally visible on aerial photographs. This information is unchecked. Red tint indicates area in which only landmark buildings are shown. Land lines within the Connecticut Western Reserve established by private subdivision. Land lines within Congress Lands north of the Old Seven Ranges based on the Ohio River Base.
