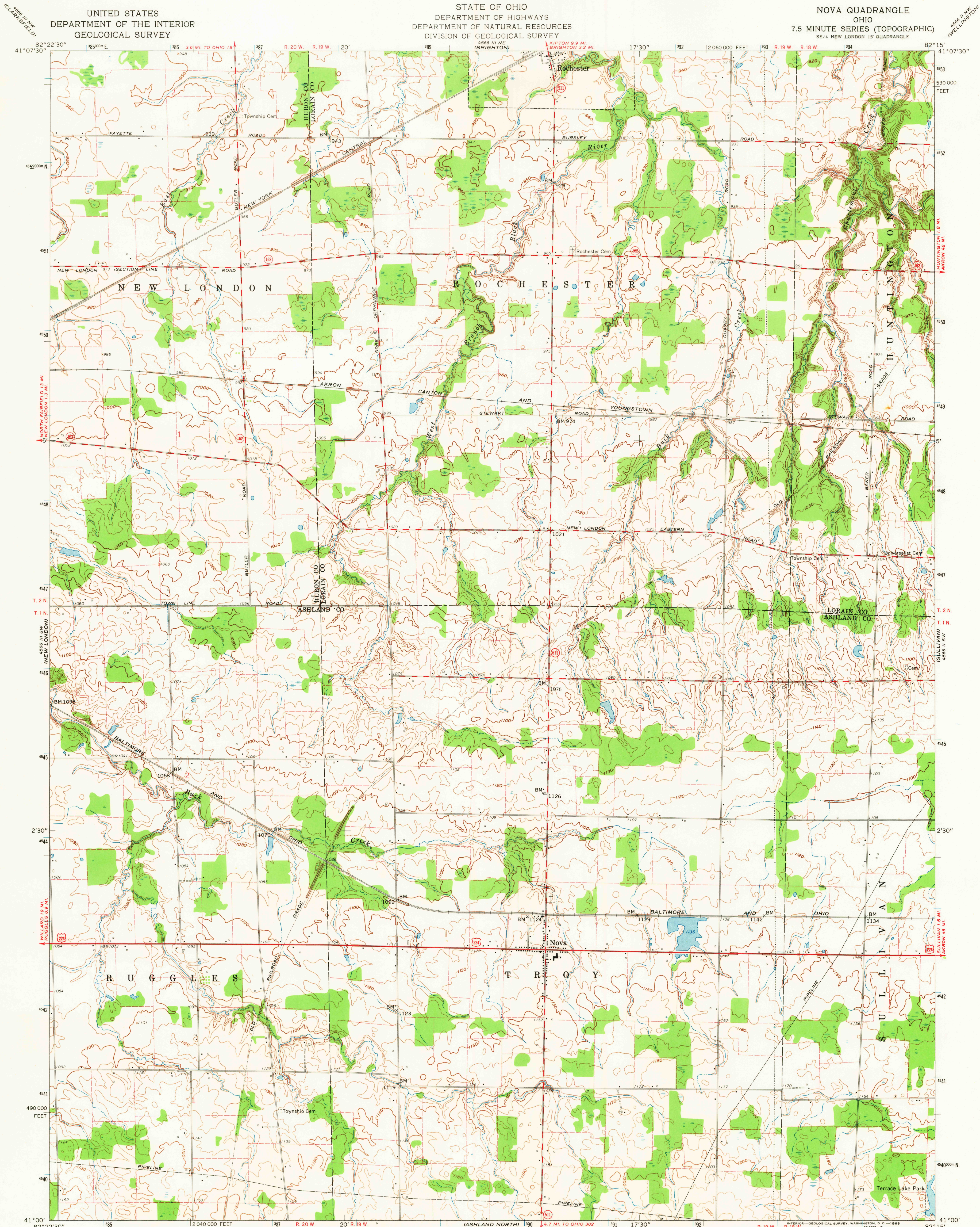

zone 17, shown in blue

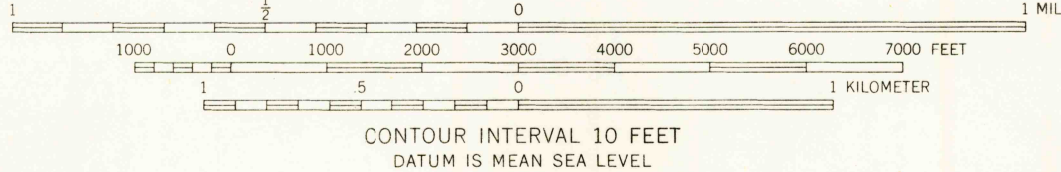
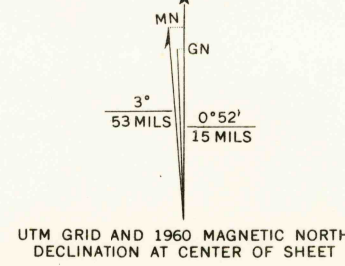
Entire area lies within the Connecticut Western Reserve
