To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 4 meters south and 7 meters west as shown by dashed corner ticks.
The state boundary as shown represents the approximate position of the low water line as determined from U. S. Corps of Engineers Ohio River charts, surveyed 1913-1914, and supplementary information Ohio area lies within the Virginia Military District.
There may be private inholdings within the boundaries of the National or State reservations shown on this map.
