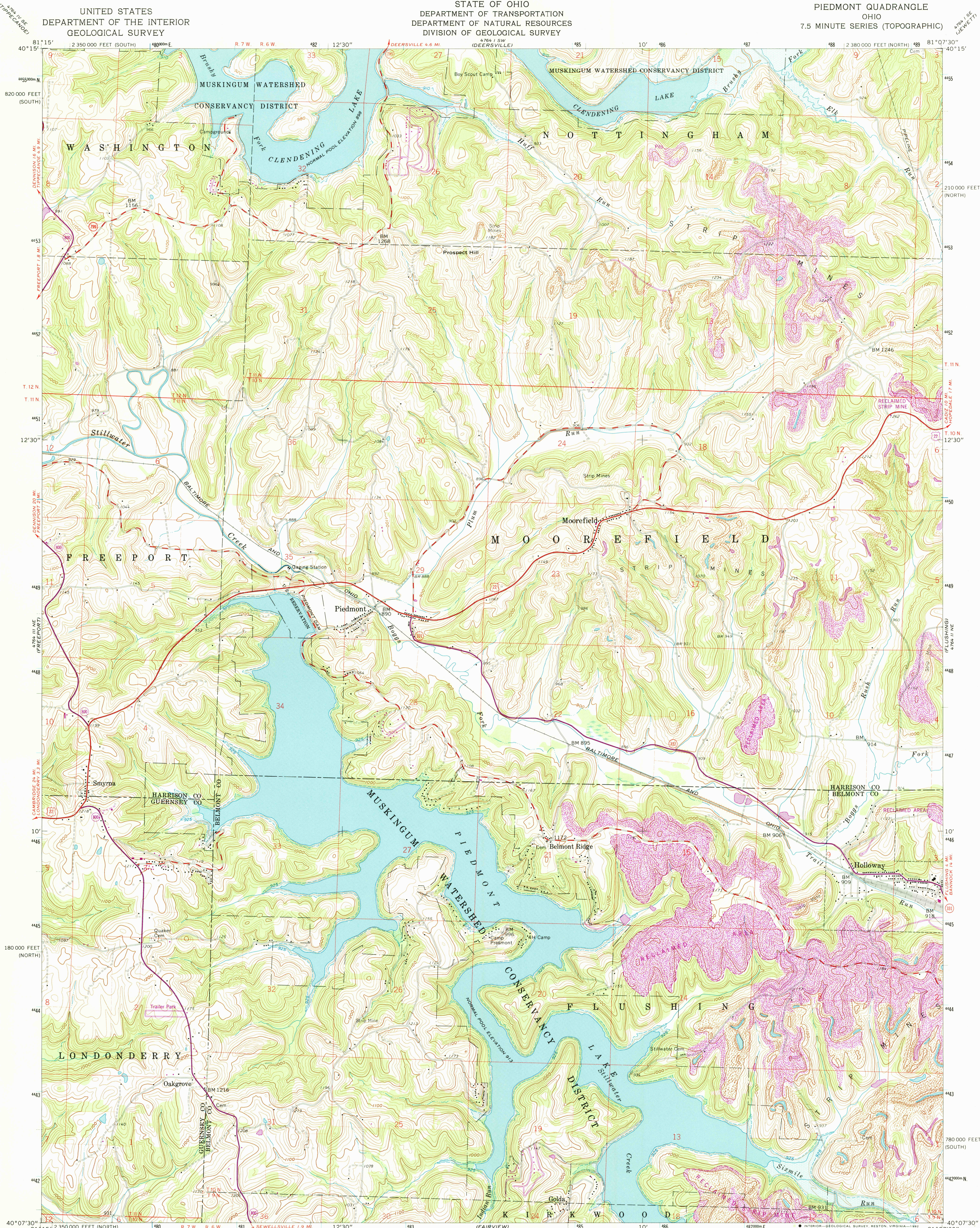

Polyconic projection. 1927 North American datum. 10,000-foot grids based on Ohio coordinate system, north and south zones

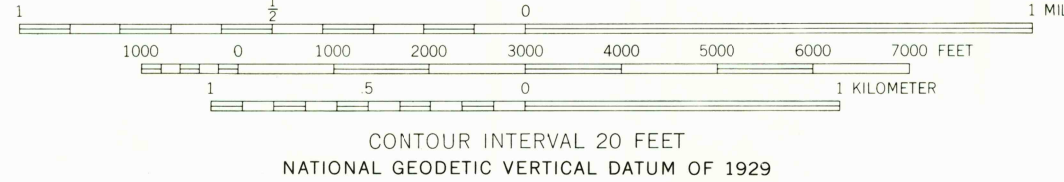
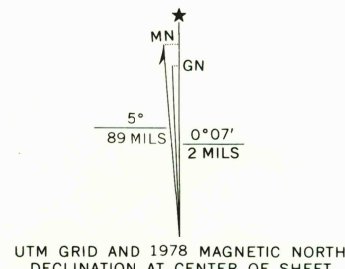
1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 17, shown in blue
