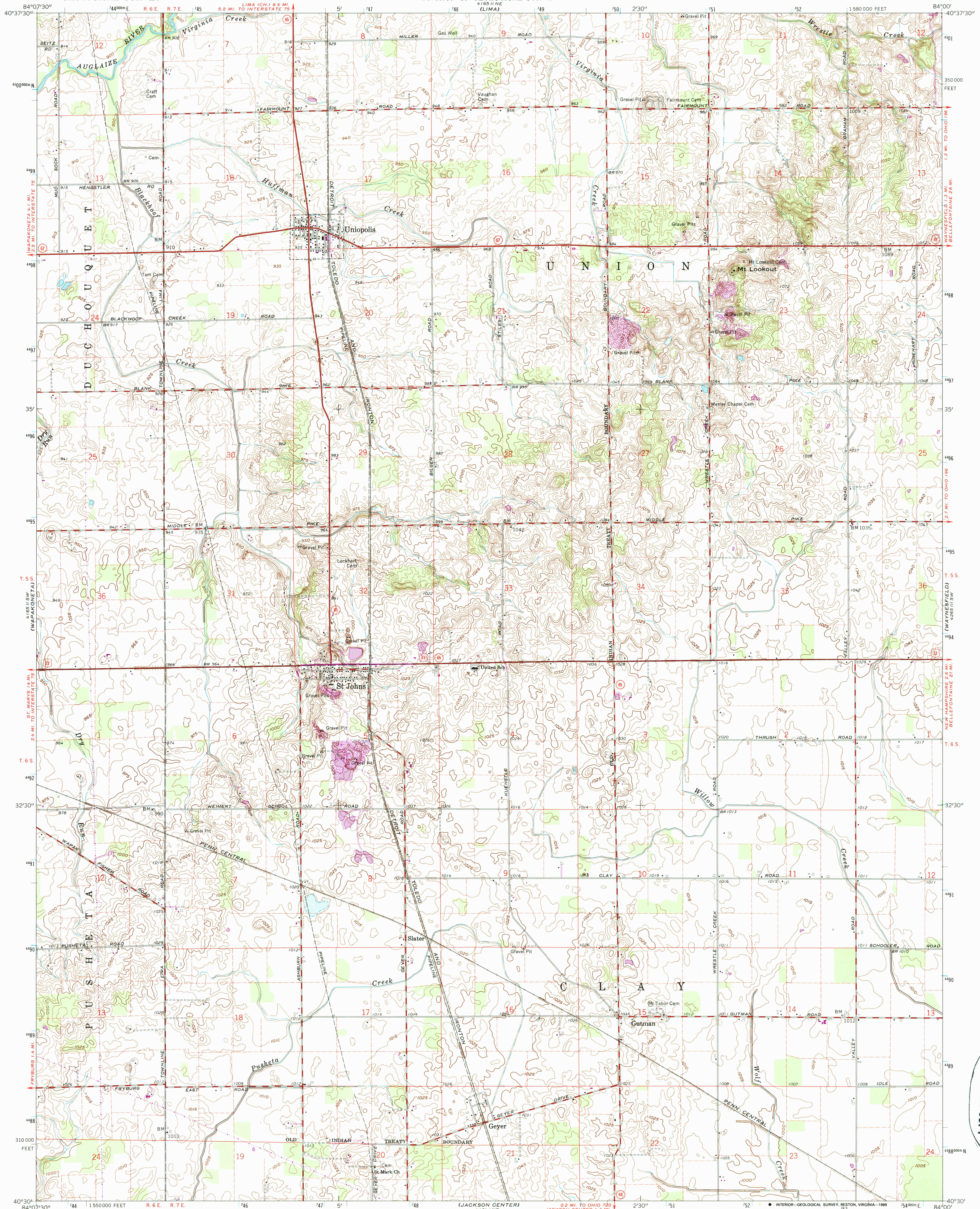

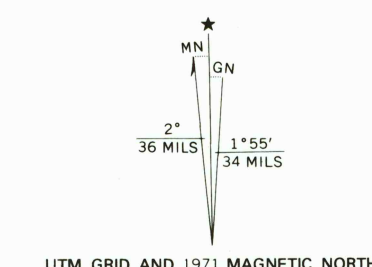
Polyconic projection. 1927 North American datum

Entire area lies within Congress Lands

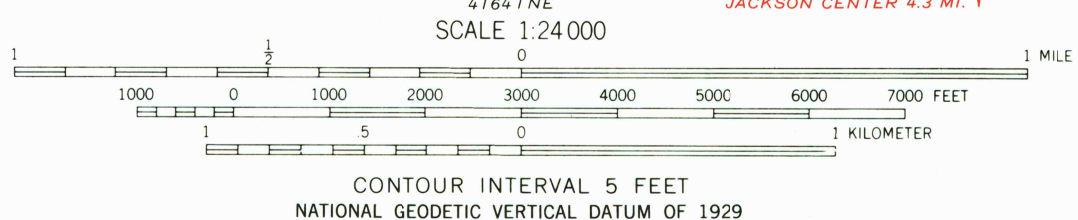
Land lines based on the First Principal Meridian
