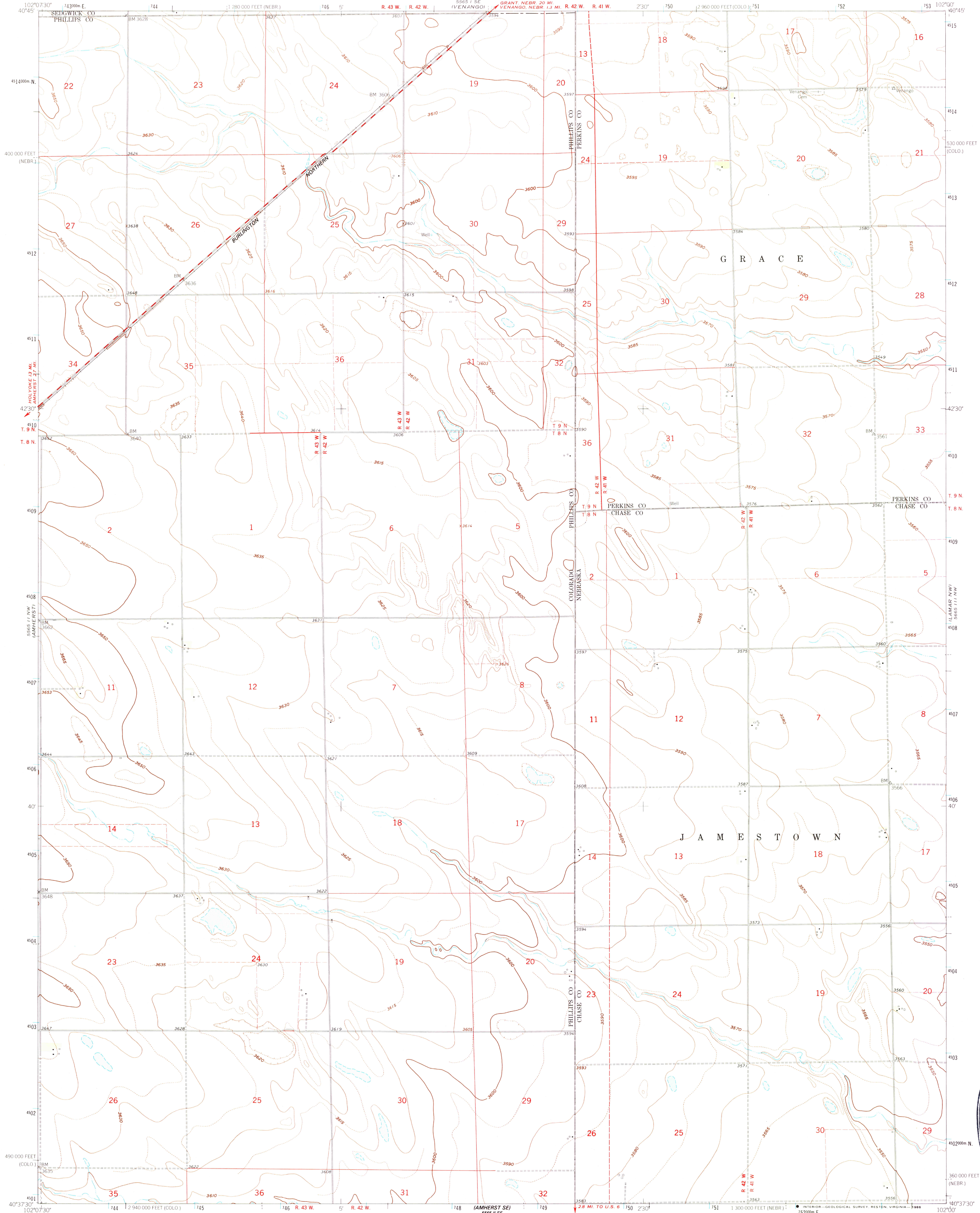

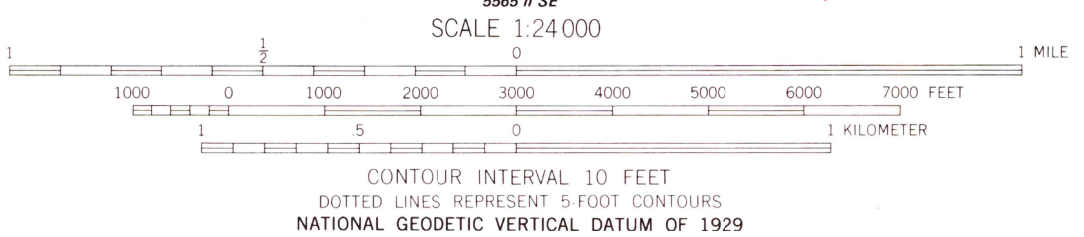

Polyconic projection. 1927 North American Datum  
10,000-foot grids based on Colorado coordinate system, north zone and Nebraska coordinate system, south zone  
1000 meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 13, shown in blue  
Certain land lines are based on cultural developments and are not reflected in the original land survey  
Fine red dashed lines indicate selected fence lines

To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 5 meters north and 39 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks
