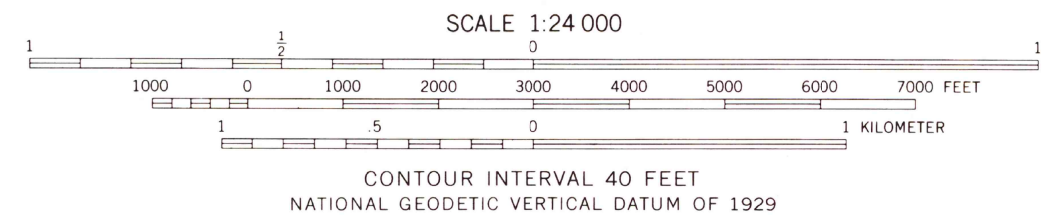
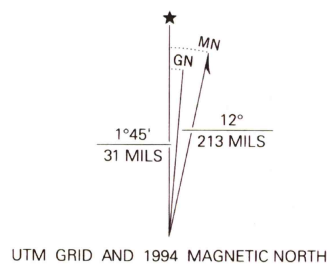

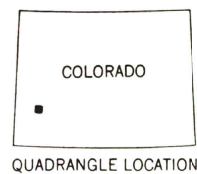
ANTONE SPRING QUADRANGLE

7.5 MINUTE SERIES (TOPOGRAPHIC)



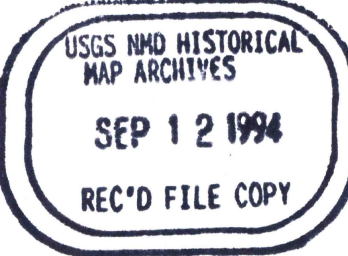
