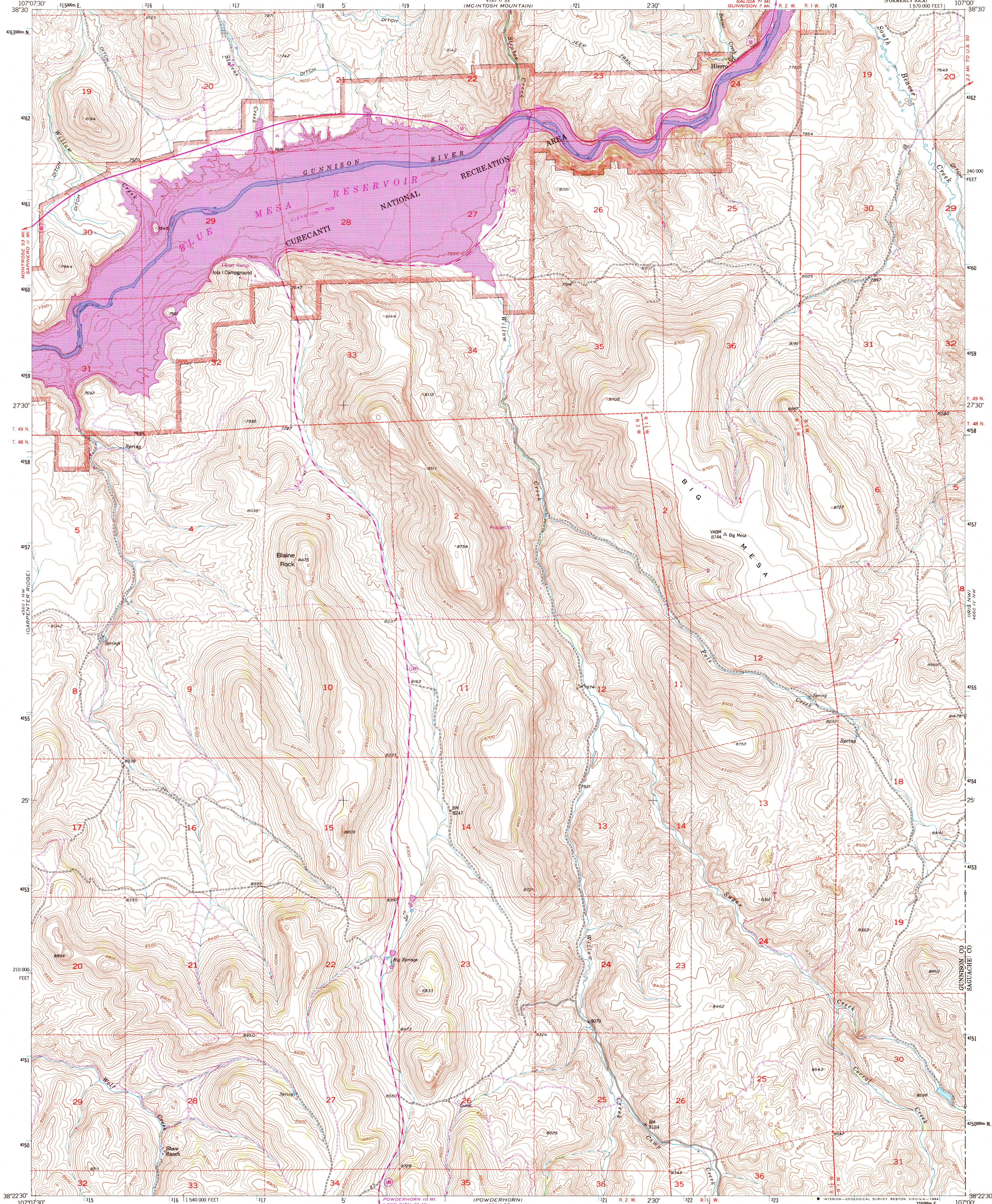

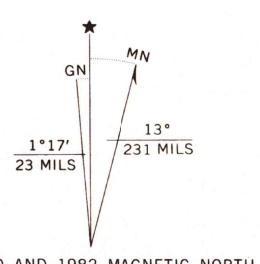

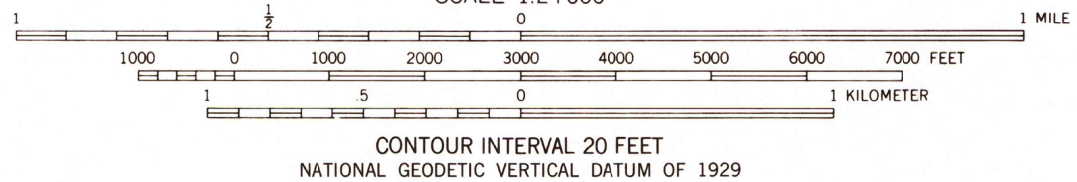
Polyconic projection. 1927 North American Datum

Dashed land lines indicate approximate locations

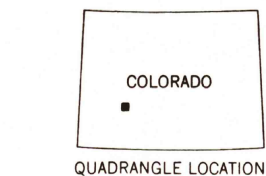
To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983

53 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks



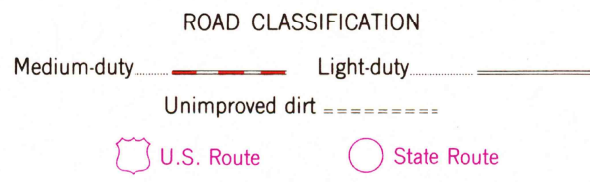
