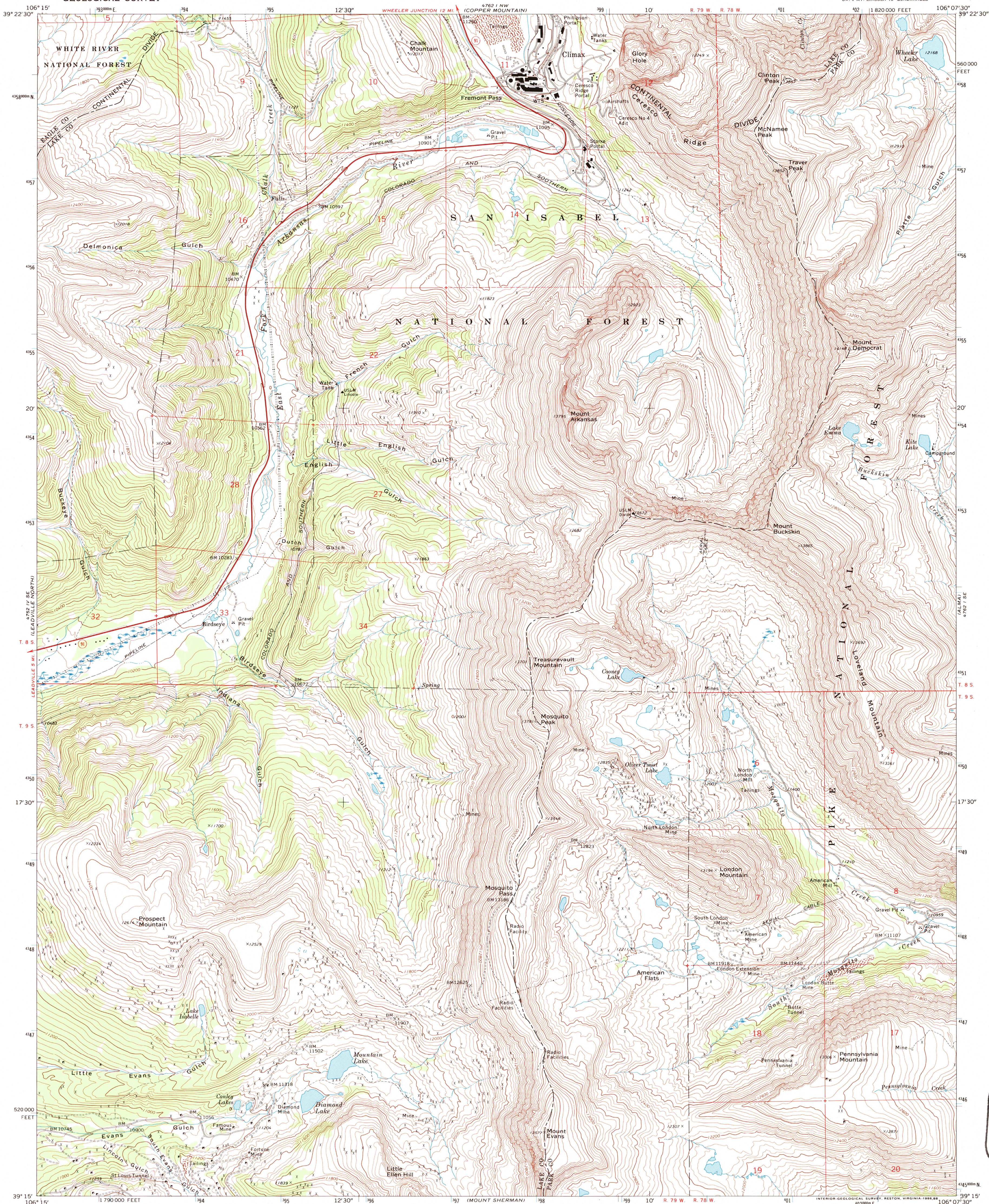

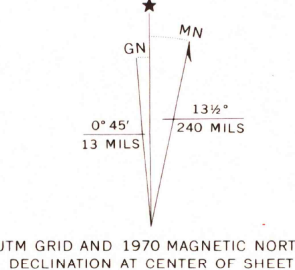

Certain land lines are omitted because of insufficient data

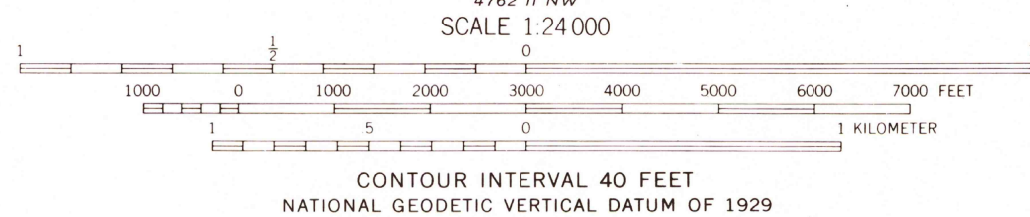
To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983
