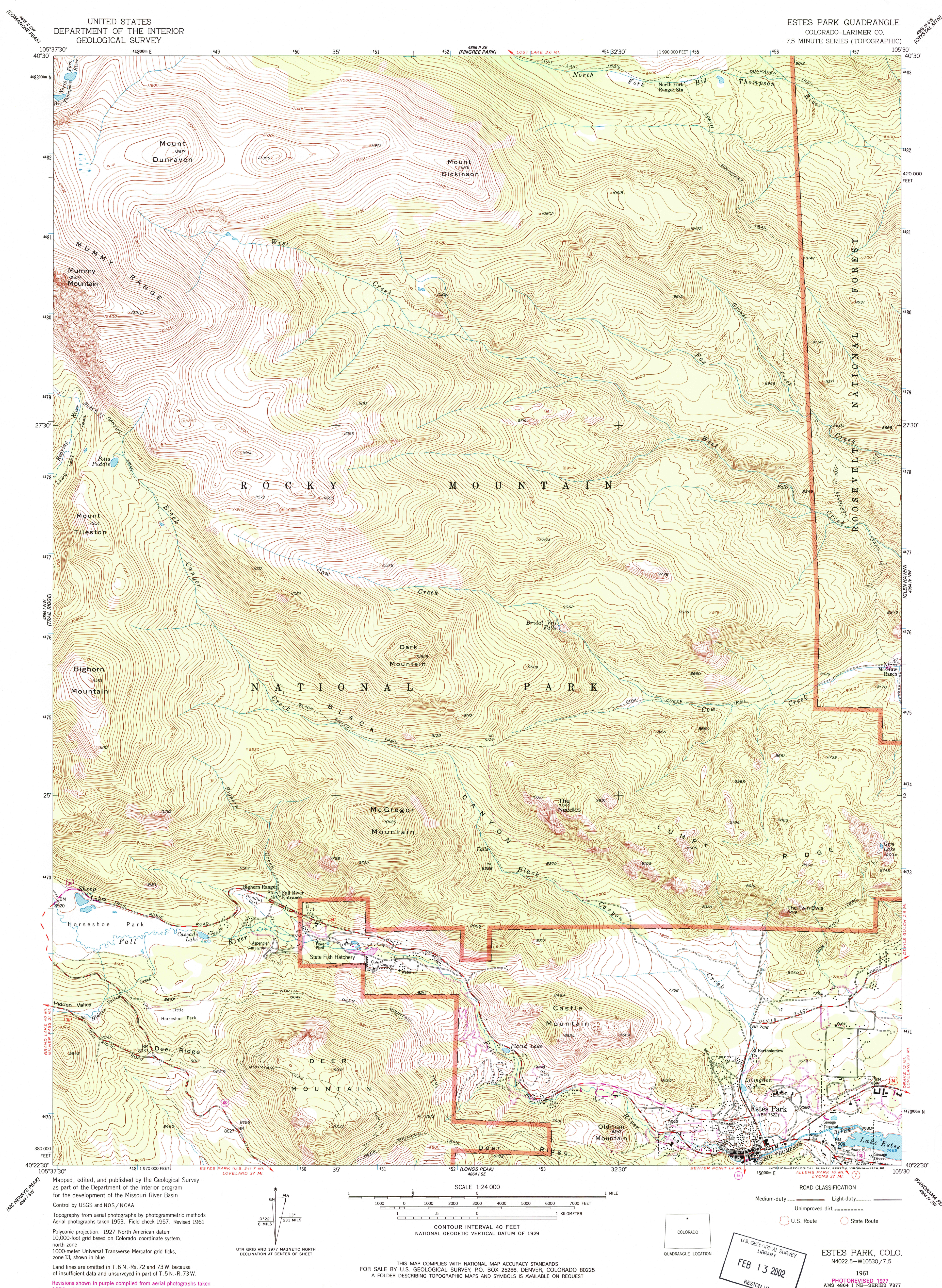

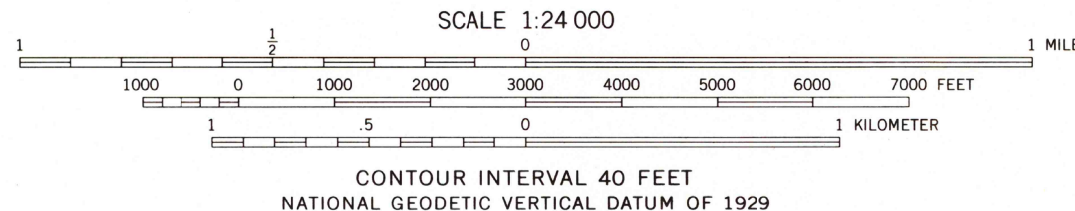
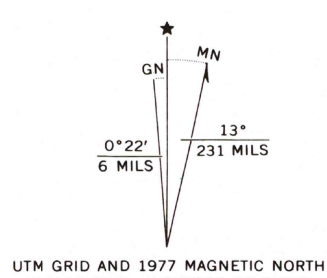
Polyconic projection. 1927 North American datum

10,000-foot grid based on Colorado coordinate system, north zone

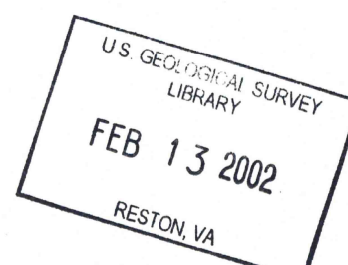
1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 13, shown in blue
