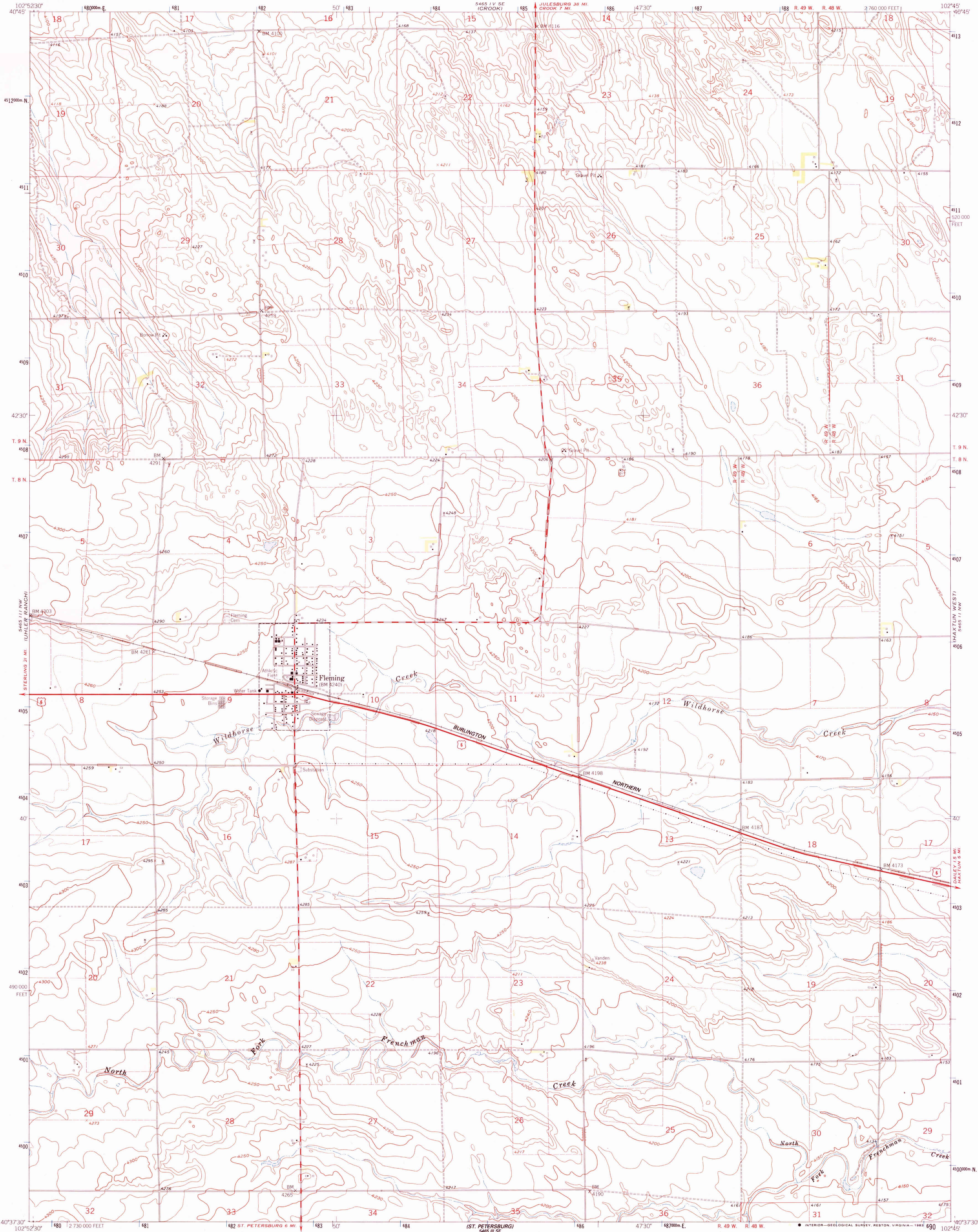

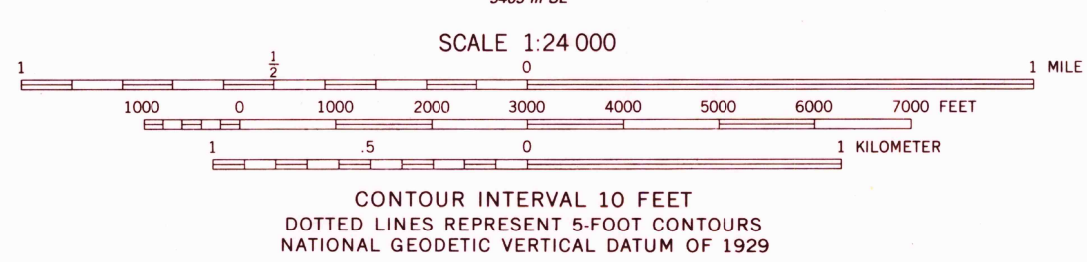
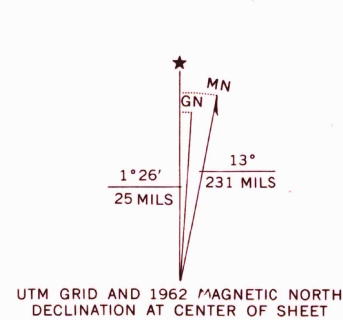

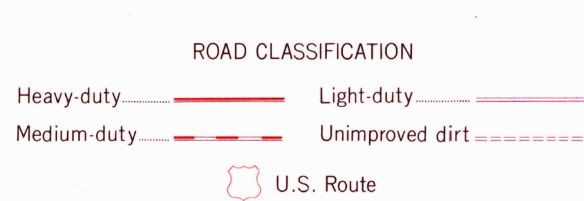
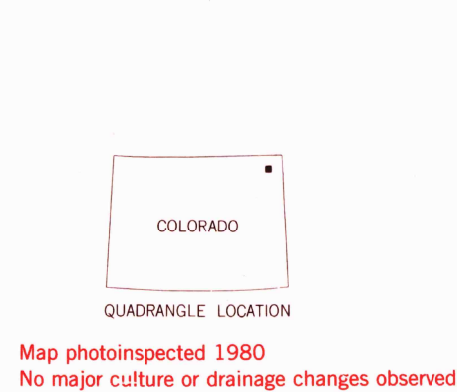

Certain land lines are based on cultural developments and are not reflected in the original land survey

To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 5 meters north and 41 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks
