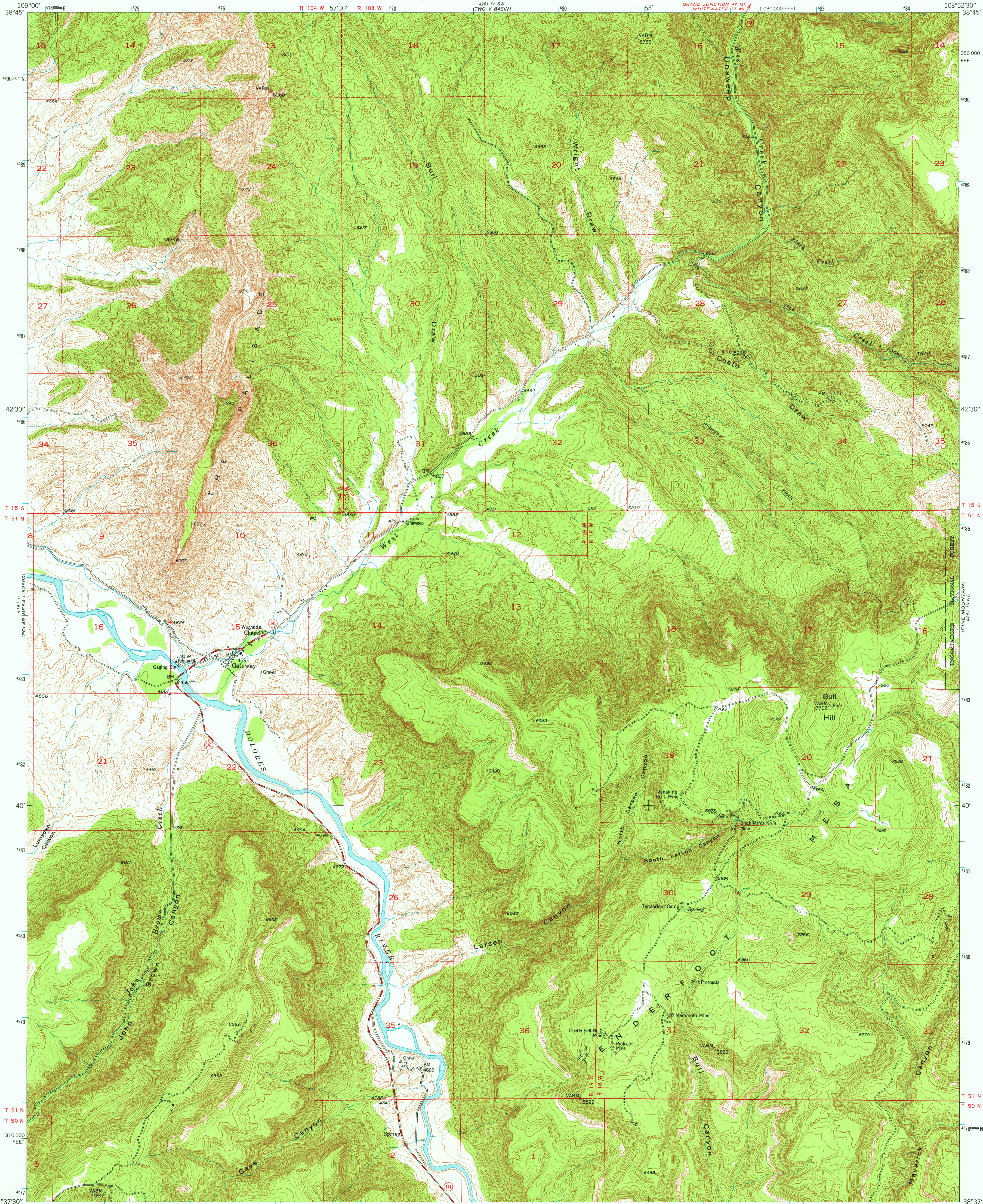

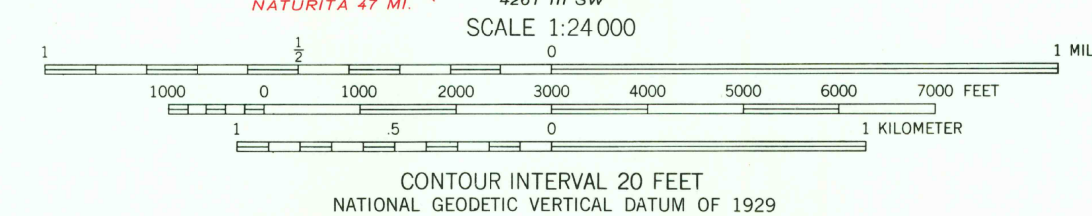
GATEWAY QUADRANGLE

(TWO V BASIN)

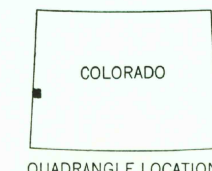
