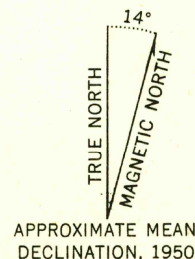
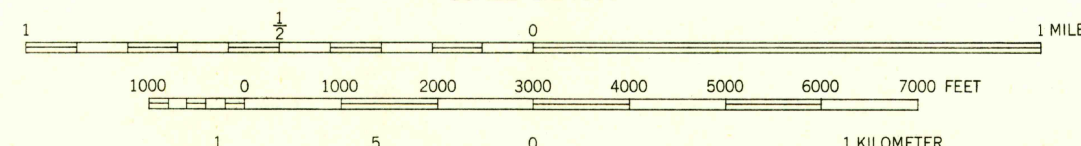

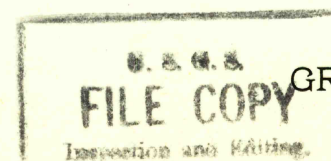
APPROXIMATE MEAN
