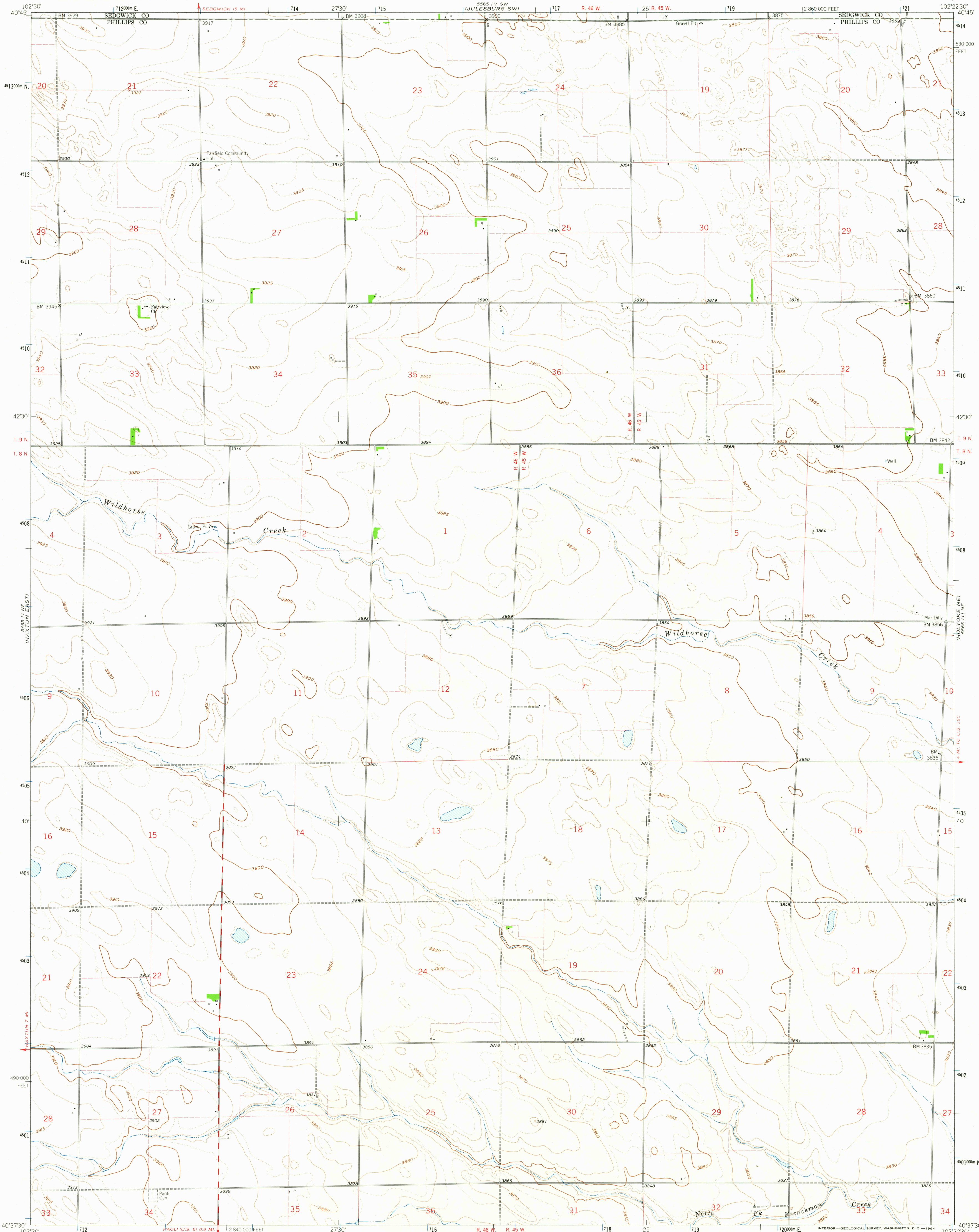

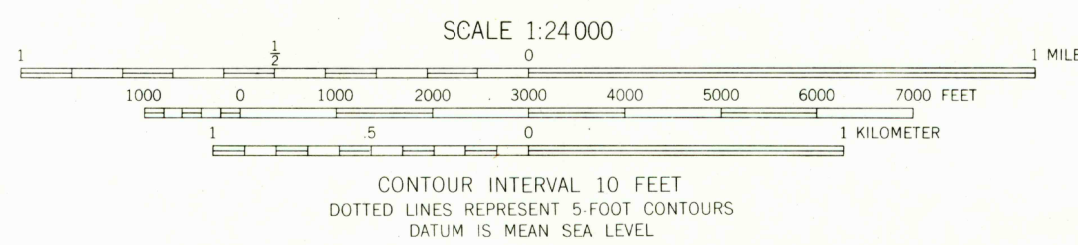
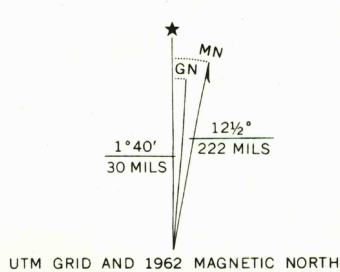

taken 1959. Topography by planetable surveys 1962

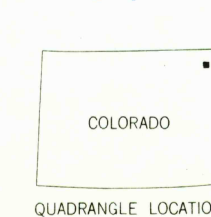
Polyconic projection. 1927 North American datum
