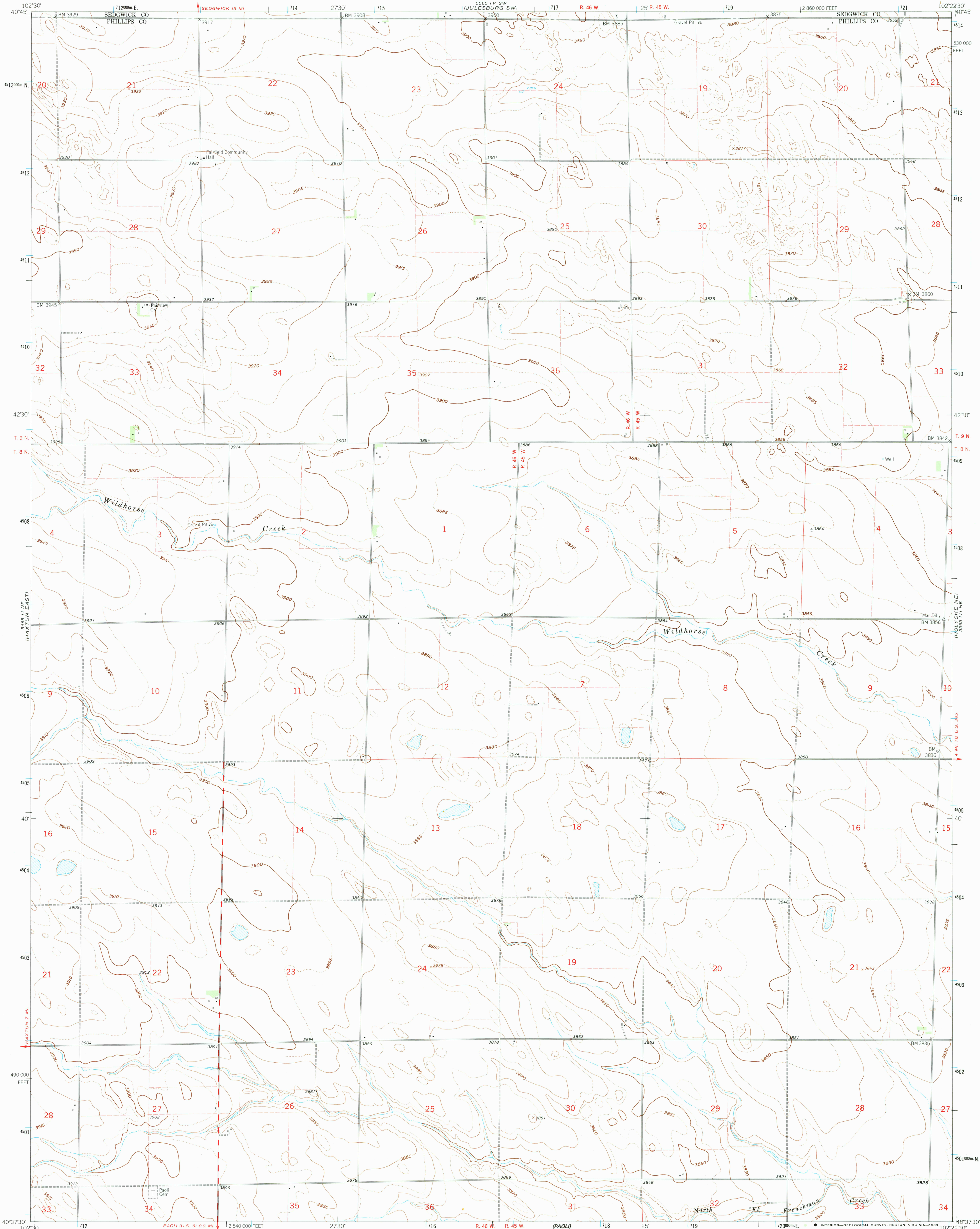

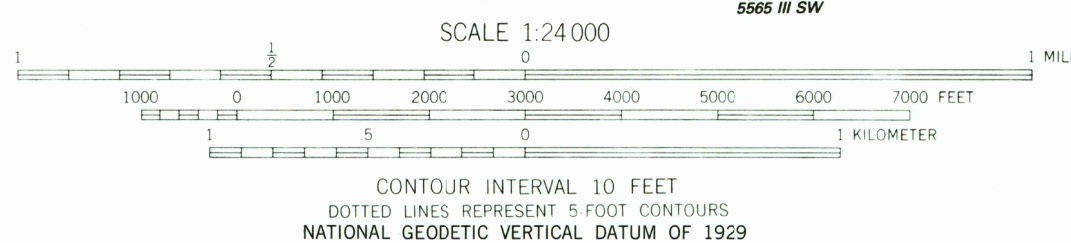

Polyconic projection. 1927 North American datum 10,000-foot grid based on Colorado coordinate system, north zone 1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 13, shown in blue

Fine red dashed lines indicate selected fence lines
Land lines are based on cultural developments and are not reflected in the original land survey

To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 5 meters north and 40 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks
