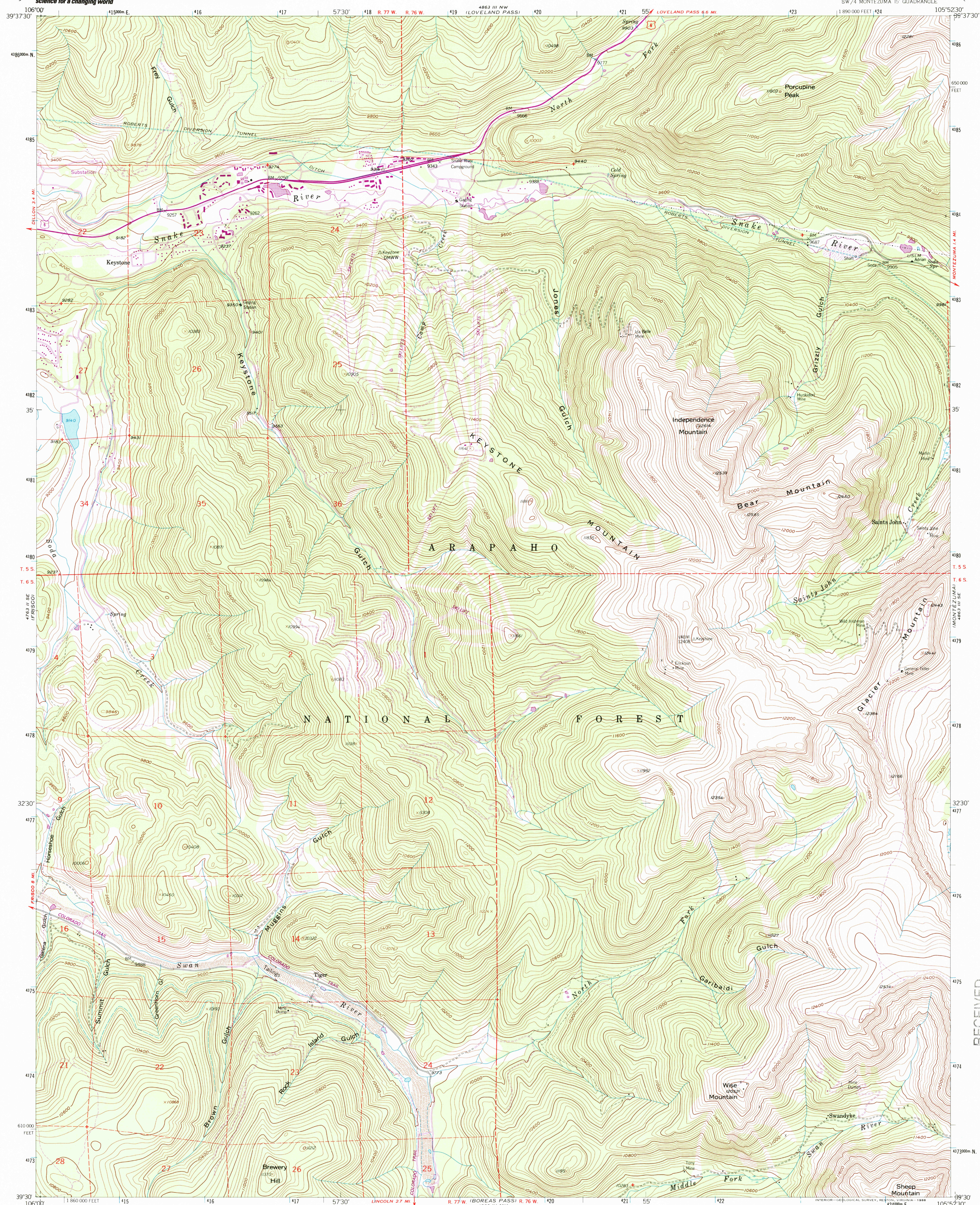

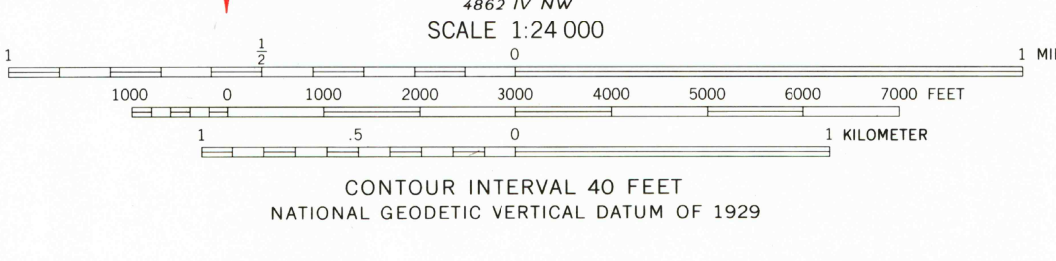
Topography from aerial photographs by photogrammetric methods. Aerial photographs taken 1953. Field check 1958.

Dashed land lines indicate approximate locations. Certain land lines omitted in T.S.S. R. 76 and 77 W. and T. 6 S. R. 76 W. because of insufficient data. All recovered corners are shown.

There may be private inholdings within the boundaries of the National or State reservations shown on this map.

To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 5 meters north and 50 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks.
