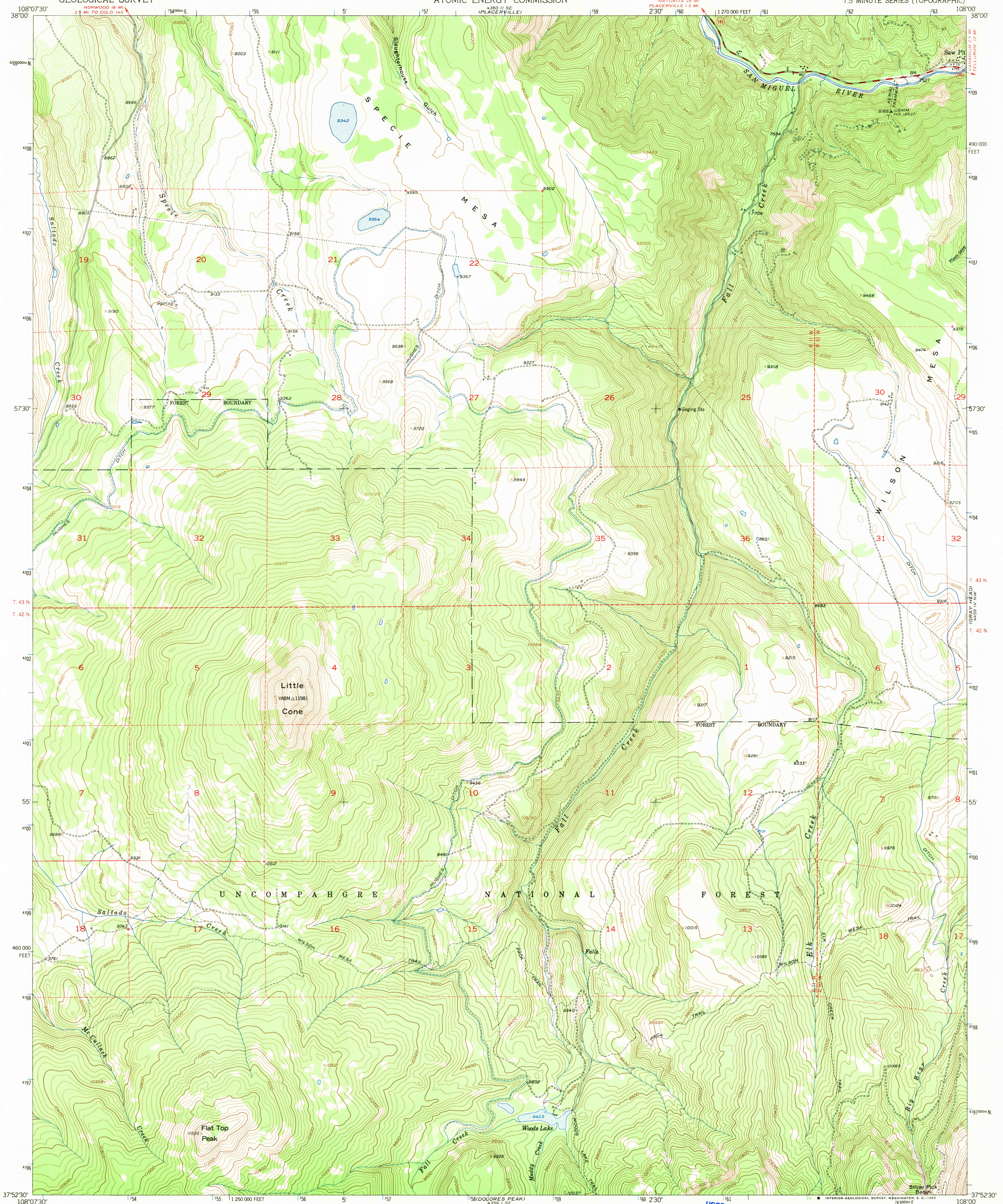

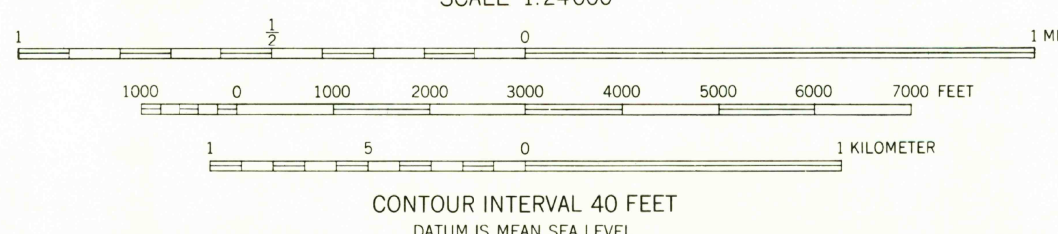
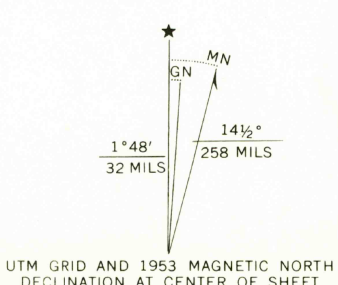
Polycyclic projection. 1927 North American datum

All mining features are inactive

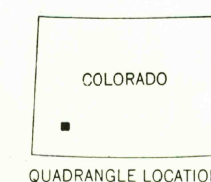
Unchecked elevations are shown in brown
