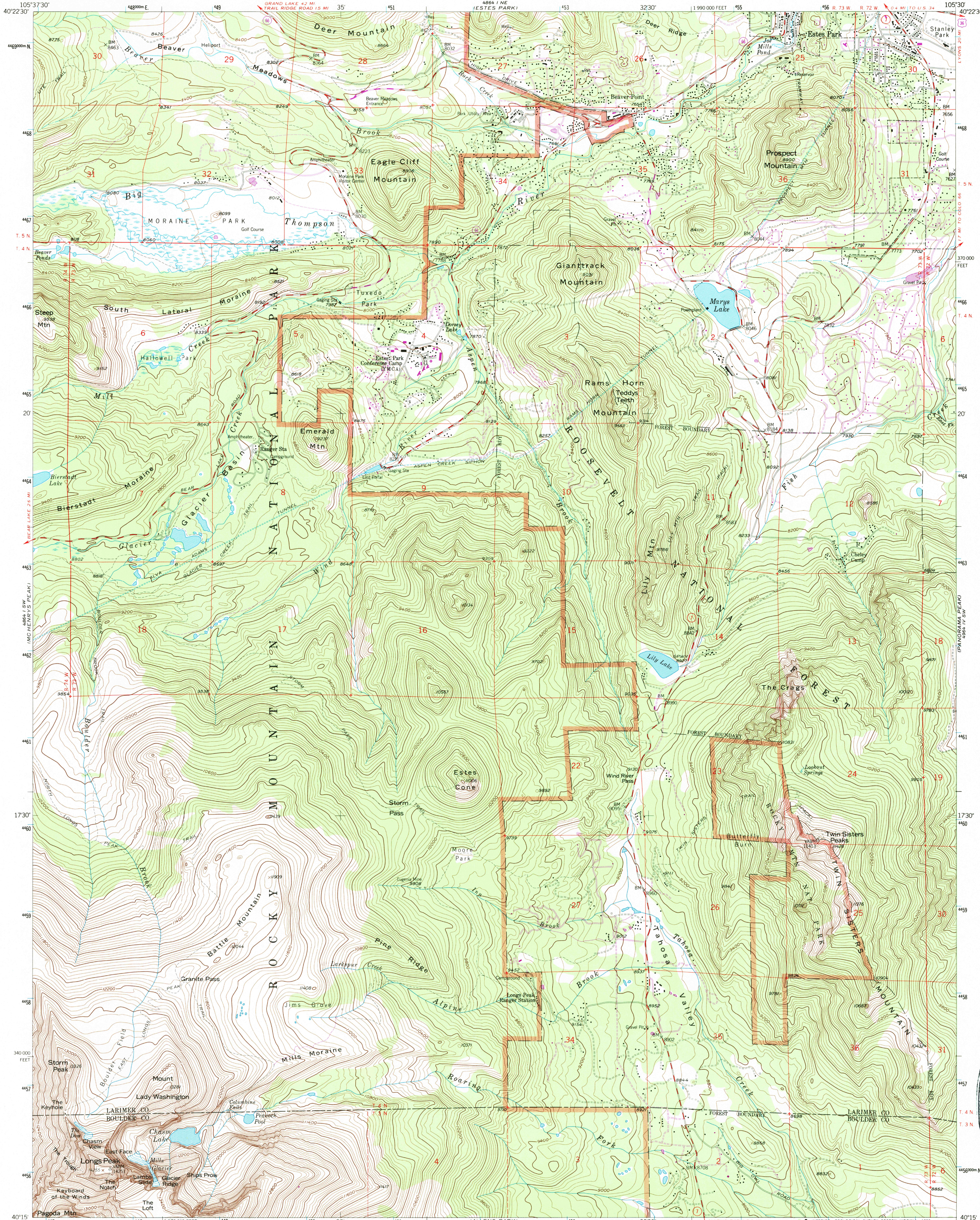

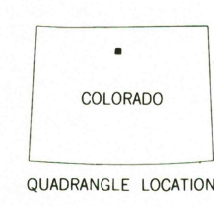
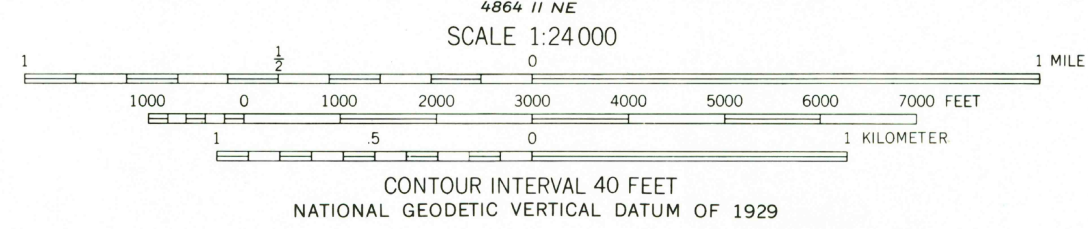

Polyconic projection. 1927 North American datum. 10,000-foot grid based on Colorado coordinate system, north zone. 1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 13, shown in blue. Dashed land lines indicate approximate locations. Land lines omitted in T. 3 and 4 N., R. 74 W., and in part of T. 3 N., R. 73 W. because of insufficient data. Land lines unsurveyed in part of T. 4 N., R. 73 W.
