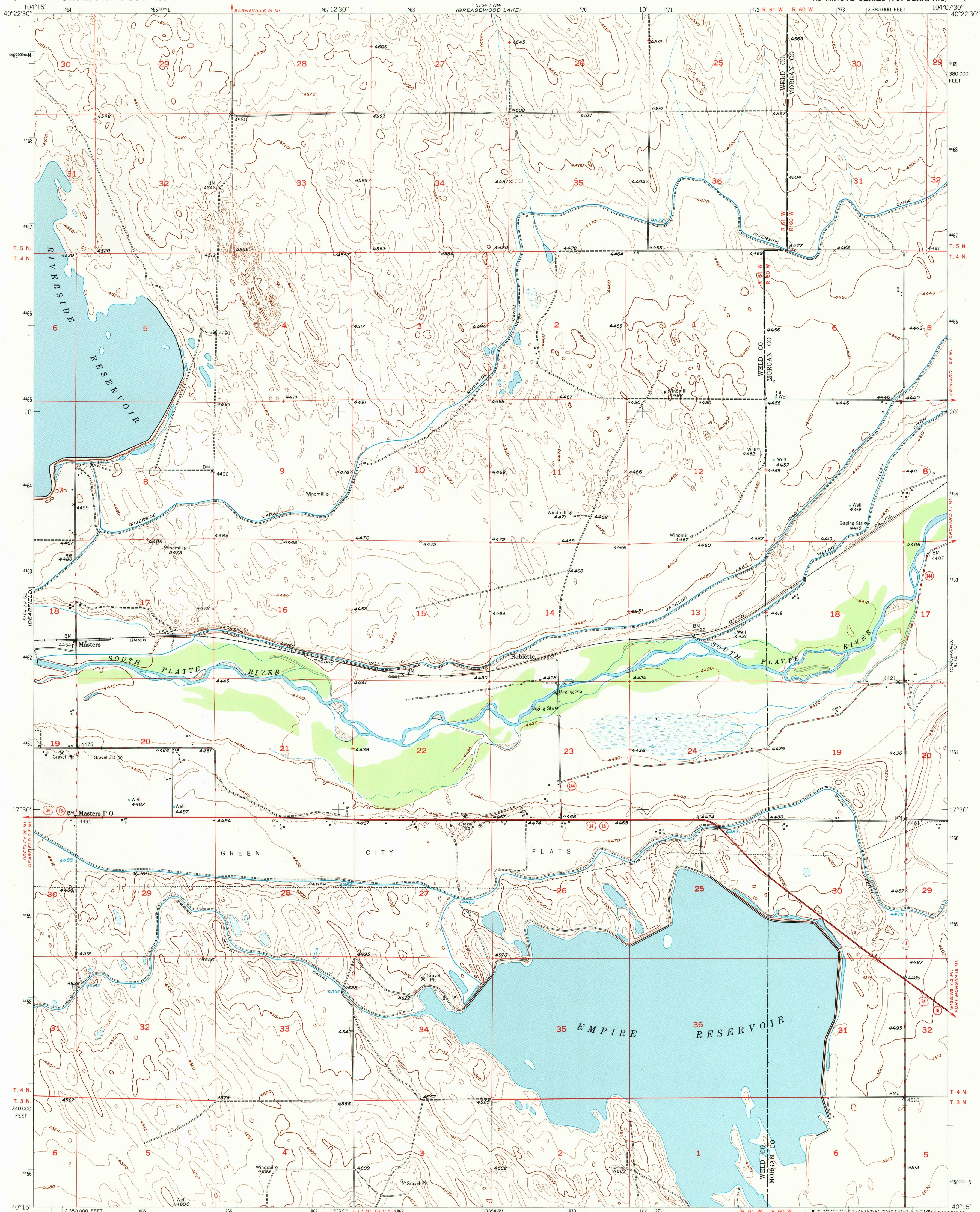

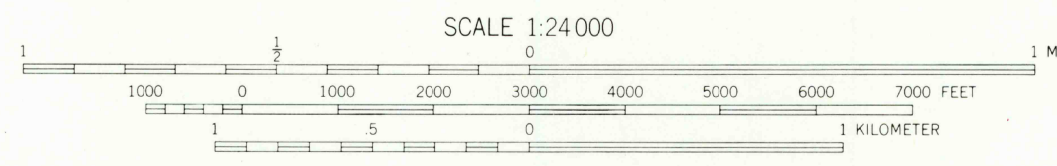

Culture and drainage in part compiled from aerial photographs taken October 1948, June, July and September 1949. Topography by plane-table surveys 1950.

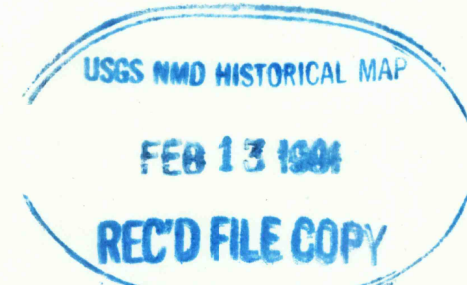
