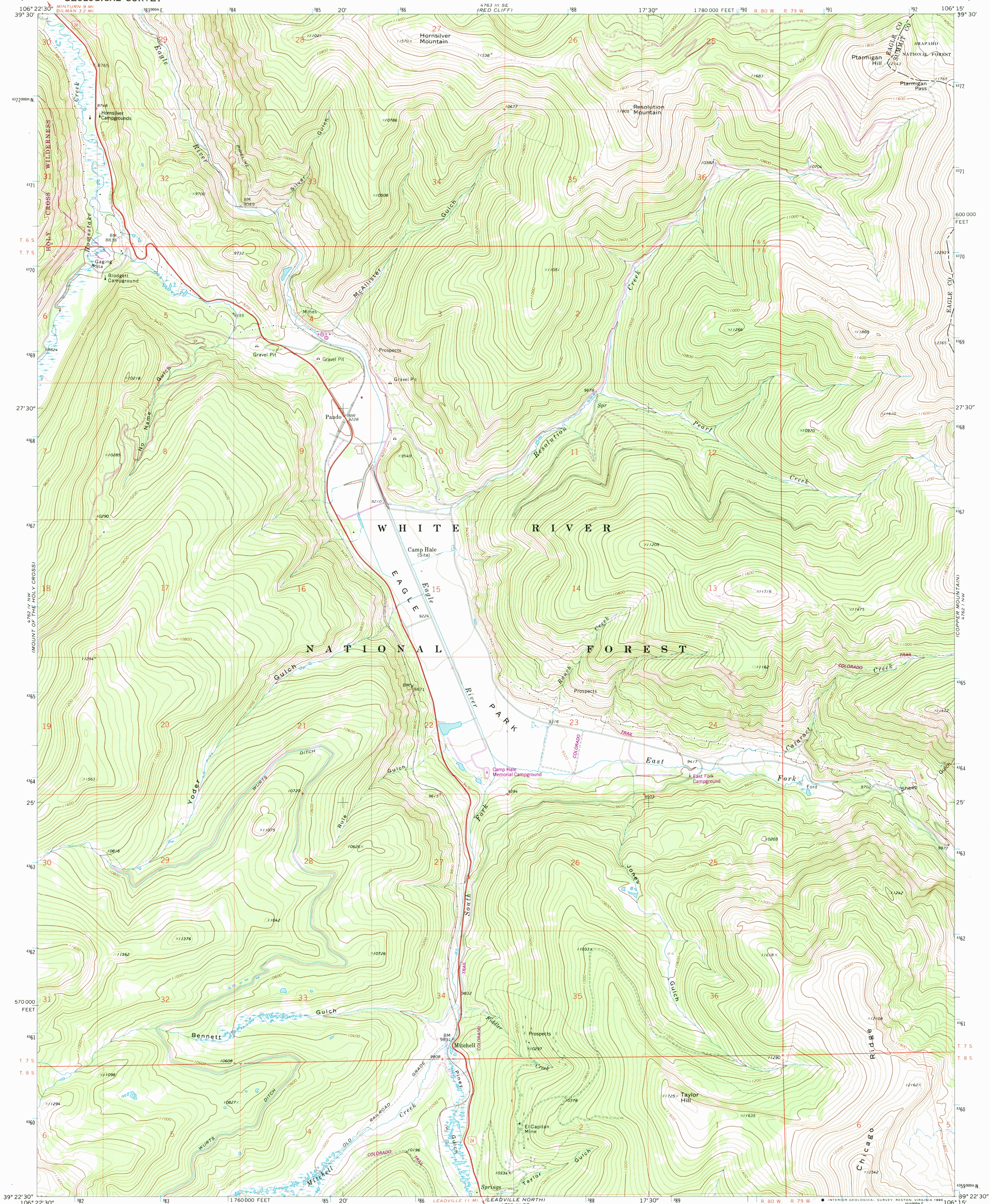

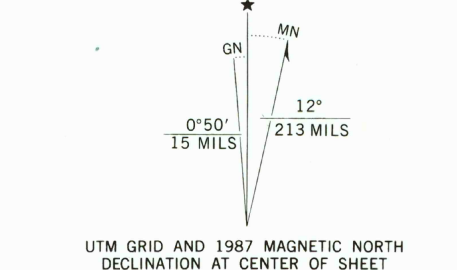

zone 13, shown in blue

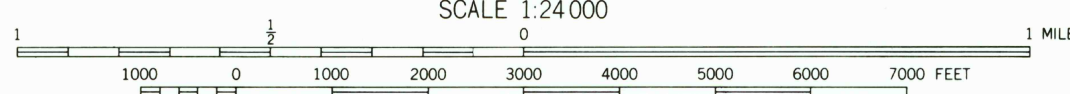
Where omitted, land lines have not been established

of the National or State reservations shown on this map

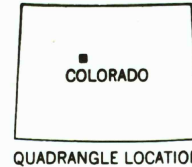
