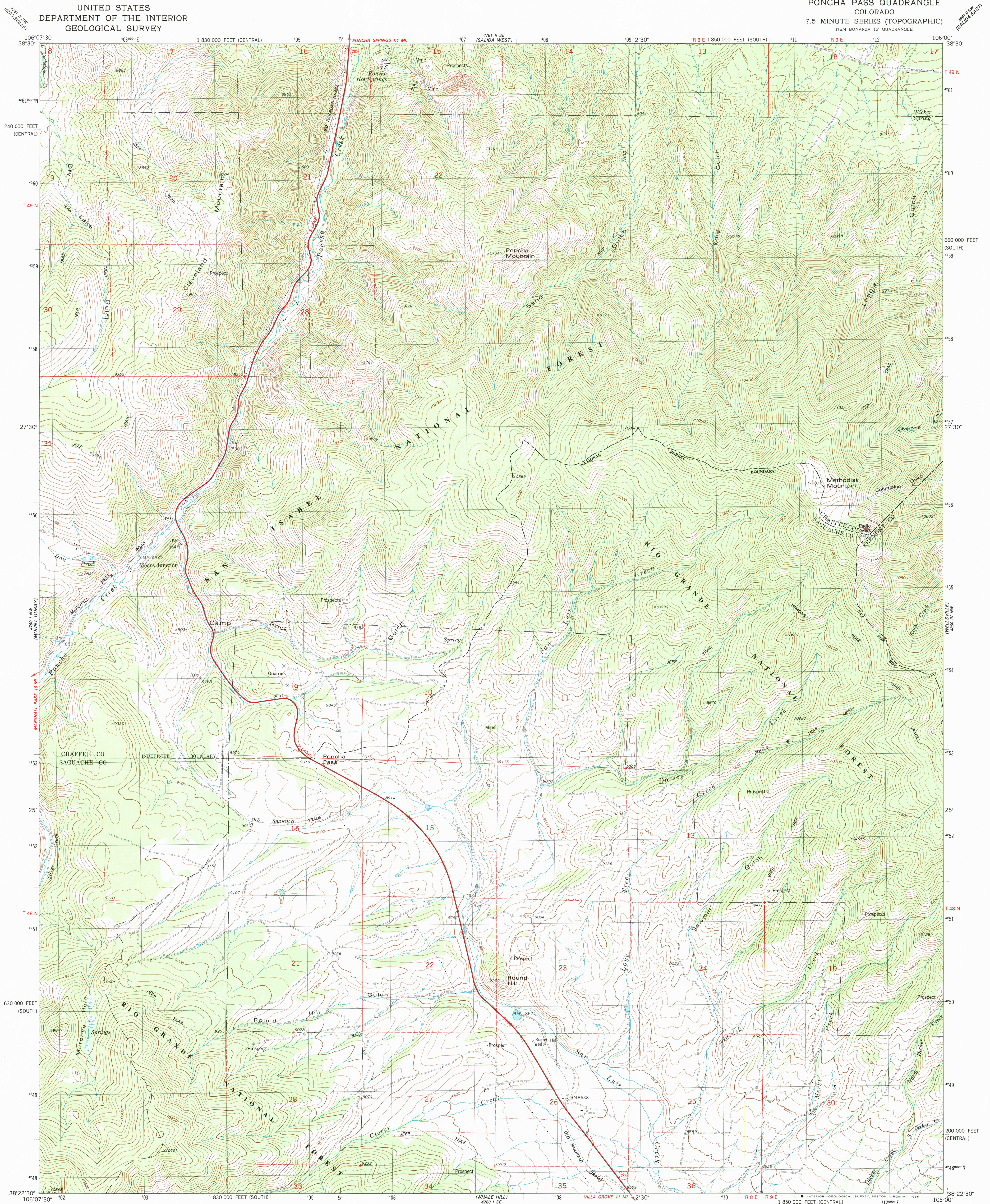

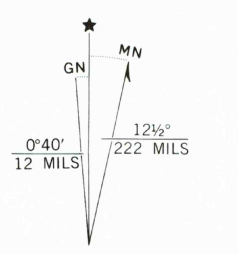
10,000-foot grid ticks based on Colorado coordinate

1927 North American Datum

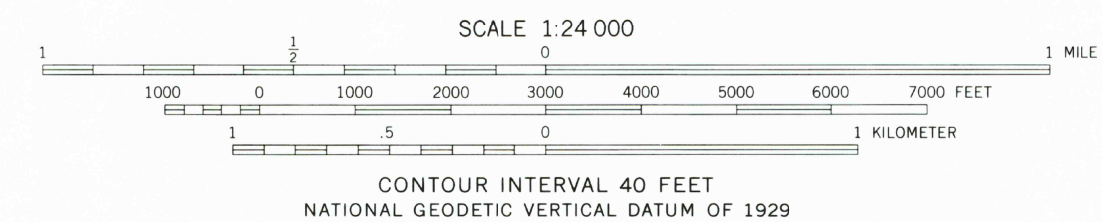
To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983

Certain land lines are omitted because of insufficient data

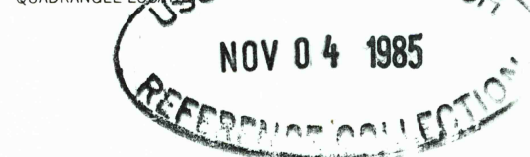
